
- (a) The life of project funding is increased from \$1,150,000 to \$6,150,000.

SUBJECT: Project Authorization Amendment--Global AIDS Prevention
and Control Program (936-5965)

Problem: Your approval is required to amend the Global AIDS Prevention and Control Program project to increase the life of project funding and to extend the project for one year. The life of project funding would be increased from \$1.1 million to \$6.1 million and the life of project period would be extended from FY 86 to FY 87. The Project Assistance Completion Date would then be June 30, 1989.

Discussion: In FY 1986, A.I.D. provided funding to the World Health Organization (WHO) in Geneva to finance the development of a global program to prevent and control AIDS. AIDS, Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome, is increasingly recognized as an extremely serious public health problem. AIDS and HIV infection have been identified as an international health concern with the potential of becoming a major barrier to the goal of health for all by the year 2000. In the face of the continuing increase in the cases of AIDS worldwide and the potential drain of country health resources, WHO has assumed an active role as the lead agency on AIDS. This program of assistance to the WHO Office in Geneva is consistent with the Agency's policy on AIDS to support the lead role of WHO in global AIDS prevention and control.

It is anticipated that \$5.0 million will be obligated in FY 87. During the March visit of Jonathan Mann, the Coordinator of the WHO Special Global Programme for AIDS, we negotiated a letter which Mr. Mann would send Bradshaw Langmaid, DAA/S&T and coordinator of the Agency's task force on AIDS. In the letter WHO will agree to place the Agency's contribution to the global programme into a special sub-account of the main WHO account for the programme. In addition, WHO will agree not to use the agency's contribution to support activities which involve the performance of, or promotion or counselling for, abortion in order to prevent perinatal transmission of the AIDS virus. After execution of the grant, and before any disbursement of funds is made under it, we should obtain the letter from WHO.

An Advice of Program Change is in the clearance process.

Recommendation: That you approve the increase to the life of project funding and the extension of the project period by signing the amended project authorization attached.
