Subject: Presidential Training Initiative for the Island Caribbean --
598-0640, Amendment No. 2

Dear Mr. Director-General:

The purpose of this Amendment to the Project Grant Agreement is to make available to the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States (Grantee) an additional sum of Two Million, One Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three United States Dollars (\$2,154,953) (and to add this amount to the Project Financial Plan) in order to finance procurement of a U.S. institutional contractor to administer additional participant training on behalf of the Grantee and its member states. This will bring total U.S.A.I.D. Project Grant Agreement funding to Two Million, Six Hundred One Thousand, Three Hundred Forty-Seven United States Dollars (\$2,601,347).

The Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

1. In Section 3.1 of the Project Grant Agreement, delete the words "Four Hundred Forty-Six Thousand, Three Hundred Ninety-Four United States Dollars (\$446,394)" and insert in lieu thereof "Two Million, Six Hundred One Thousand, Three Hundred Forty-Seven United States Dollars (\$2,601,347)."
2. In Section 2 of Annex I, a sixth paragraph is added which reads "Using funds earmarked in the Revised Project Financial Plan, U.S.A.I.D. will directly procure the services of a U.S. contractor, through competitive bidding, who will be responsible for design of U.S. training programs, placement of trainees, proper documentation, and monitoring and follow up evaluation activities. This procurement will be coordinated with the OECS, and the contractor selected will work in conjunction with OECS and U.S.A.I.D. counterpart staff."
3. In Section 3 of Annex I, a third paragraph is added which reads: "Subject to the availability of funds, U.S.A.I.D. intends to obligate additional funds to this Grant to complete U.S.A.I.D. funding for the Project in accordance with the Project Financial Plan."

4. Attachment A to this letter shows the revised Project Financial Plan by Expense Category.

All other terms of the Project Grant Agreement remain unchanged.




