SUBJECT: Authorization Amendment: Demographic and Health
Surveys (DHS) Project, 936-3023

Action: Your approval is needed to amend the authorization for
subject project to permit obligation of Child Survival funds.

Discussion: The DHS project represents a unique source of child
health and child survival data and is the Agency's only
independent evaluation mechanism for child survival
interventions. Based on our experience in the population
sector, the collection and analysis of child survival data will
have a tremendous impact on improving program management and
evaluation. Additional resources are needed now to insure that
child survival data are collected and analyzed at the very
beginning of the Agency's efforts in child survival.

The DHS project is currently being funded from the Population
and Health accounts. The health content of DHS is now
significantly greater than originally planned due to the
addition of information for children under three. Current
estimates of funding requirements for health and child survival
efforts total \$4 million. The Office of Health is expected to
contribute \$2.6 million to the project. The authorization of
\$1.5 million in child survival funds will insure that the Agency
does not miss the opportunity to establish an evaluation system
for measuring progress in our child survival activities as well
as generate data for reporting to Congress.

The OYB and FY 1988 request for the Office of Population include
Child Survival funds for this purpose. The required Advice of
Program Change has been prepared.

Recommendation: That you sign the attached authorization
amendment to permit obligation of up to \$1.5 million in Child
Survival funds for the DHS project.
