1. Pursuant to Section 103 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Area Development project was authorized on January 3, 1978. The project was substantially revised and renamed the Human Settlements & Natural Resource Systems Analysis (SARSA) project in May, 1983. It was extended through FY 84 on July 18, 1983. SARSA was then amended on March 23, 1986 and extended through FY 88. The authorization is hereby amended as follows:

- a. The authorized final year of obligations is extended from FY 88 until September 30, 1989; and
  - b. The project Assistance Completion Date is extended from September 30, 1988 until September 30, 1990.
2. The authorization cited above remains in force except as hereby agreed.

SUBJECT: Human Settlements & Natural Resource Systems  
Analysis (SARSA) Project (931-1135)

Problem: Your approval is requested to: a). extend the final year of obligation for this project beyond 10 years, from FY 1988 to FY 1989; and b). extend the Project Assistance Completion Date from September 30, 1988 to November 30, 1990.

Discussion: The Human Settlements & Natural Resource Systems Analysis (SARSA) Project began in 1978 as the Area Development project. It was substantially changed in 1983 when an amended project paper was written. The revised project focused on three research themes: (1) settlement/resettlement, (2) natural resource analysis, and (3) rural/urban linkages. Since 1983, the project has done exceedingly well. For example, it has (a) conducted research in nineteen countries, representing work in each of the regions; (b) obtained twenty-nine buy-ins from nineteen countries and nine buy-ins from two regional bureaus totaling \$4,000,200 (a ratio of buy-ins to core of slightly better than 3:1); (c) carried out collaborative research with regional bureaus (AFR - rural/urban dynamics analysis, river basin development and LAC - rural/urban linkage and natural resource analysis); and (d) developed an oversight role in river basin development, in conjunction with USAID/Dakar and the OMVS. In addition, it has been the key associated S&T project in the development of the Fragile Lands Initiative (FLI) of the LAC Bureau and the initiation of the Development Strategies for Fragile Lands (DESFIL) project.

This year (FY 87), because of budget cuts, SARSA's funding has been reduced. The project paper called for a planned level of \$600,000; the OYB level is \$400,000. The project is currently scheduled for its last year of funding in FY 88. S&T/RD would like to extend the authorization for the final fiscal year of obligation from FY 88 to FY 89. This will allow the project to receive funds in FY 89 sufficient to keep the project at or near its planned total funding level. The funding is necessary for SARSA to produce all of its scheduled products. These include the planned synthesis, guidelines, and policy documents



for each research theme in final version and with good quality control. The extension will also ensure satisfactory completion of the related field activities.

Simultaneously with the one year extension for funding, S&T/RD would like to extend the Project Activity Completion Date (PACD) from 9/30/88 to 9/30/90. This will ensure orderly completion of all revisions of final project documents.

Recommendation: That you approve the extension of the final year of obligation from FY 88 to FY 89, and the Project Activity Completion Date (PACD) from FY 88 to November 30, 1990.
