



Problem: Your approval is needed to authorize an extension of
the Energy Technical/Service Support (ETSS) Project to 30 June
1988.

Background: This project provides access to scientific,
technical, engineering and management expertise in energy areas
required by A.I.D. and offered by the Department of Energy (DOE),
the national laboratories administered by DOE, and other selected
organizations.

Usage of this project over the past eight years has included: a
symposium on Jordanian solar ponds; the services of a wind expert
to evaluate the wind and solar energy aspects of a Cape Verde
renewable energy project; the services of Brookhaven National
Laboratory on the formulation of coal-water fixed fuels from
Philippine coal; and the services of Dr. David Jhirad and a
secretary to work closely with the Office of Energy in providing
a planning strategy that sets national priorities for the role of
energy and power supply systems in critical development sectors.
This latter activity requires that the ETSS project be extended
in order to complete this work. No additional funds are required.


