Section A. - Purpose of Grant of Attachment 1 is changed to read as follows:

"A. Purpose of Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to provide:

- core support for a family planning program in Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Kitts-Nevis, St. Lucia, and St. Vincent as more specifically described in Attachment 2 entitled "Program Description", and
- limited support for a family planning program in Anguilla, Aruba, Bahamas, Belize, British Virgin Islands, Curacao, St. Maarten and Suriname.

The countries eligible to receive limited support may be provided (i) information, education and communication materials (e.g. posters, pamphlets, booklets, video tapes, radio spots) up to a maximum value of \$1,500 per year and (ii) technical assistance for training of not more than \$1,500 per year."

Section H.2 - Geographic Code of Attachment 1 is revised to add the countries eligible to receive limited support.
