ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR HEALTH

FROM: S&T/H, Ann Van Dusen *(Ann Van Dusen)*SUBJECT: Approval of an Amended Project Authorization for the
Primary Health Care Operations Research (PRICOR II)
Project (936-5920.2)

Problem: Your approval is required to amend the project authorization of the subject project to explicitly permit acceptance of A.I.D. Mission and Regional Bureau funds ("buy-ins").

Discussion: This operations research project was authorized in 1981, with the authorization amended in 1985 to permit the development of the PRICOR II project. Neither project authorization explicitly mentions the acceptance of funds from non-central sources.

The projects research strategy has been modified to focus on A.I.D. Mission health programs in child survival and several Missions, including Thailand, Haiti, and Colombia, and the Regional Office for Central America and Panama (ROCAP) have committed funds to the PRICOR II project. More such actions are anticipated. The project's funding authorization anticipates approximately \$2 million in non-central funds.

Conclusion: A.I.D. Mission and Regional Bureau buy-ins are an important and appropriate source of funding for PRICOR II activities. The project authorization should explicitly provide for accepting such funds.

Recommendation: That you approve an amended project authorization permitting acceptance of non-central A.I.D. health funds within the authorized level by signing the attached amended project authorization.
