SUBJECT: Increased Authority for Funding of Pediatric Chronic
Diarrheal Disease Research Training - Children's
Hospital of Buffalo (936-5940)

Problem: Your approval is needed to increase life of project
funding for the subject project by \$150,000.

Discussion: The scope of the project has not changed.
Specific tasks to be performed during the phase-out period are
to complete, document and write up studies that were initiated
by the physician-scientist Fellows. The Fellows program is
sponsored by the Cooperative Agreement between USAID and the
International Institute for Infant Nutrition and
Gastrointestinal Disease (IIINGD). The completion of these
studies will result in two things: research protocols and
published papers.

The Cooperative Agreement called for the development of 12
valid research protocols. The final evaluation team found that
the protocols that were developed were of unacceptable quality
and Dr Lebenthal is proposing that the phase-out period be used
to correct this deficiency. The Associated Research Centers in
developing countries will use these research protocols for
fund-raising purposes.

The development of manuscripts for publication is central to
research activities. Some USAID-sponsored IIINGD Fellows have
been successful in preparing manuscripts of sufficient quality
to be published. In some cases, journals have accepted
Fellows' papers contingent upon the completion of further
work. This leaves the Institute with the responsibility for
doing this work in order that the research findings be
published.

Recommendation: For the above reasons that you approve a
12-month extension to the project and an increase to the LOP by
signing the amended project authorization attached.
