ANNEX A
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. Project Title:

African Manpower Development Project

2. AID Project:

No. 698-0433.9

3. Project Purpose:

The project will assist the Grantee in providing the priority human resource development needed for managerial and technically skilled manpower in the Sudan to undertake development activities. Priority areas of training are in such fields as training of trainers, project analysis and management, computer maintenance, banking, educational methodology, financial management and transport statistical analysis.

4. U.S. Government Contribution:

This Grant Project Agreement provides, and hereby obligates, one hundred and twenty thousand U.S.Dollars (\$120,000) for non-academic training as specified in the Country Training Plan (CTP).

5. Grantee Contribution:

In support of training hereunder, the Grantee will:

- a) Provide local costs incidental to the departure of the participants, such as transportation from working site to Khartoum, exit visa and passport fees, medical exam and immunizations and continuance of participant's salary while he/she is in training.
- b) Provide the international travel Khartoum/London/Khartoum.
- c) Insure that the Sudanese participants trained under this Project will return to the Sudan upon completion of their study programs, and will serve for an appropriate period of time in positions having relevance to their training and national development.

6. Implementation:

- a) Specific nominations and proposals for training hereunder will be made, in accordance with the FY 1986 Country Training Plan, to USAID/Sudan by the Director General of the National Training

Directorate, Council of Ministers. AID agreement to, and processing of, these nominations will be pursuant to AID I IO/P documentation (Handbook 10 Participant Training).

- b) Unless otherwise agreed to by the parties, the funds granted under this agreement will be used in accordance with the planned training program enclosure I. The parties may agree to changes in this training program and to changes in any of the other implementation procedures described in (A) above using project implementation letters without formal amendment of this agreement.

7. Special Provisions:

- a) Except as otherwise agreed to by A.I.D., all goods and services financed under this grant for training activities shall have, with respect to goods, their source and origin, and with respect to services, their nationality, in countries included in A.I.D. Geographic Code 941 or in Sudan. For the purposes of this provision, source, origin and nationality shall be determined in accordance with the rules contained in A.I.D. Handbook 1, Supplement B.
- b) Unless A.I.D. otherwise agrees in writing, transportation by air of property of persons financed under this grant will be on carriers holding United States certification to the extent services by such carriers is available.

Subject: Justification for a Waiver

Problem: Your approval is required to authorize a waiver to exempt GOS from paying international travel (London USA portion) for AMDP Participants FY 86.

Discussion: In addition to the continuing developmental needs, the Sudan is faced with severe fiscal and balance of payment problems and a political situation which is in a state of flux.

AMDP provides training support to the GOS in critical areas outside the main thrust of the USAID/Sudan funded projects. The GOS lacks funds for the training of personnel in institutions not supported by AID projects, but it is critical to the GOS' ability to manage its development effort, of which the US program is a critical components.

The current financial and budgetary constraints do not allow the GOS to allocate any of its resources for international travel (London/USA). The costs range from \$10,000 to \$11,000.

Recommendations: According to Handbook 10, Chapter 15, the cost of international travel is paid by the host government unless the Mission Director (in the case of Mission funded projects) has authorized full or partial waivers and has so notified DS/IT. Based upon this factors outlined above it is recommended that you approve the waiver to exempt GOS from paying International Travel (London/USA portion) for FY 86 AMDP participants.
