SUBJECT: Third Amendment of the Authorization for the
Environment and Natural Resources: Expanded
Information Base Project (931-1209)

Problem: You are requested to extend the final year of obligation of the Environment and Natural Resources: Expanded Information Base project (931-1209) from FY 85 to FY 89 and extend the PACD from August 30, 1987 to July 31, 1989 (the date that is ten years from the first obligation).

Discussion: The project was authorized as a four year activity in June, 1979, at a funding level of \$2,178,000, and with a PACD of October 30, 1983. On July 31, 1979, the National Park Service (NPS) entered into a Participating Agency Service Agreement (PASA) with the Agency for International Development (A.I.D.) to assist in the area of natural resource management. Under this project, the NPS developed state-of-the-art review papers (Phase I); prepared case studies (Phase II); and design aids (Phase III) for coastal resources, humid tropics, rangelands, and integrated regional planning. Workshops (Phase IV) were held in the four A.I.D. regions to orient A.I.D. Mission staff to the materials developed in earlier phases and to field test the utility and relevance of the materials.

In June, 1983, the PASA was amended to add two additional phases: the design and implementation of three training modules for use by LDC trainers (Phase V) and the institutionalization of training in LDC institutions (Phase VI).

In FY 79, the initial life-of-project cost was \$2,178,000. An increase was authorized to \$2,490,000 in FY 82 and to \$3,100,000 in FY 85.

In FY 85, the PACD was extended to September 30, 1987 in order to complete activities. In FY 87, the PACD was first extended to September 30, 1988 in order to make final payment to NPS and later was further extended to March 31, 1989.

The National Park Service has asked for an extension, which would extend the project to ten years, to audit their accounting system with various sub-contractors. It is their intention to use prior fiscal year unexpended funds of approximately \$30,000 to provide A.I.D. with additional copies of publications produced under this project. Activities under this project have been successfully concluded and all terms and conditions have been met.

Recommendation: That you approve the extension of the final year of obligation to FY 89 and PACD of July 31, 1989 for the Environment and Natural Resources: Expanded Information Base project by signing the attached Project Authorization and Allotment of Funds.




