ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR HEALTH

SUBJECT: Increased funding authority and extension of life of project for Project 936-5958, Milwaukee International Health Training Center (MIHTC)

Problem: Your approval is required to authorize an increase of \$750,000 to the A.I.D. grant to the Milwaukee International Health Training Center (MIHTC) Project and to extend the life of project to November 30, 1992.

Discussion: A.I.D. awarded a grant to the Milwaukee International Health Training Center in 1986 to assist it to develop an international health training capacity in Milwaukee. The MIHTC has progressed towards the goals of its original grant from A.I.D. as described in the 1986 grant agreement. Its staff and various institutions in the Milwaukee area have gained useful experience and taken initial steps toward establishing a self-sustaining capacity in international health training. A number of goals set forward in the grant agreement have been met, notably the implementation of two overseas workshops in Malawi and Zimbabwe during 1988. Based on that progress and continued support from Milwaukee County for this activity, the MIHTC submitted to A.I.D. an unsolicited proposal for a substantially expanded follow-on activity.

At the same time, the FY 89 evaluation conducted by ST/H concluded that half of the goals in the original grant agreement have been modified or postponed. The MIHTC has not fully tapped the skills of the institutions and individuals in the Milwaukee area. The MIHTC is still far from reaching a level of development where it is competitive with established international health training programs. The MIHTC has yet to formulate a long-term strategy for its own development and staffing, for competing for contracts and grants, and building an independent capability in the health sector in developing countries. The evaluation also recommends increased staff, particularly with expertise in international health training and professional consultation.

Therefore, the Office of Health recommended to Milwaukee County (Attachment One) and the County has responded positively to (Attachment Two) an extension of the current grant to support the work of the Center and enable it to complete the original scope of work of the current grant.

Two elements of the original scope are particularly critical and urgent for the future of the Center: 1) an in-depth assessment and development of a long-term strategy to mobilize the interests and capabilities of institutions and individuals in the Milwaukee area as they relate to health problems in the developing world and 2) the development of a careful, considered long-term plan to develop the Milwaukee International Health Training Center so that it is competitive with other funding institutions and builds a strong, diverse financial base.

The attached recommended modifications to the program description give additional emphasis to these aspects of the Center's program (Attachment 3). An obligation of \$250,000 is planned for FY 89.

Notification to Congress: A Congressional notification is being prepared.

Recommendation: That you approve the extension of this project from December 31, 1988 to November 30, 1992, and increase the life-of project funding from \$425,000 to 1,175,000 by signing the attached amended project authorization (Attachment 4).
