PROBLEM: Your approval is requested to amend the authorization for the subject project to increase the level of funding for missions, regional bureaus, and other AID/W offices to contribute up to \$9,000,000 in support of project activities.

DISCUSSION: This project was authorized for five years on September 15, 1981 at a level of \$12,850,000 for S&T/AGR funding. It was amended on May 9, 1986 to increase the authorization by \$9,000,000 to \$21,850,000 and extend the authorized final year of obligation to FY 1989; on May 13, 1988 to increase the approved level by \$6,000,000 to allow missions, regional bureaus, and other AID/W offices to obtain services under the project through delivery orders issued under a Basic Ordering Agreement; and on May 24, 1989 to increase the S&T/AGR life of project funding by \$10,500,000 to a new total of \$32,350,000 and extended the authorize final year of obligation to FY 1994 and the life of project to September 30, 1995.

At that time, the level for missions, regional bureaus, and other AID/W offices was not increased. After reviewing the anticipated 'buy-in' level, it is now apparent that the approved level to allow missions, regional bureaus and other AID/W offices to access the expertise developed under this program must be increased to \$9,000,000. The CRSP program will benefit from the information and experience gained by providing services to LDCs related to the research undertaken by the participating universities. Accordingly, we propose to increase the approved level to permit the procurement of services from the participating universities related to their soils management research up to a new total of \$9,000,000. The companion basic ordering agreement (BOA) will be amended accordingly.

These additional funds will be separately authorized under various mission, regional bureau, or other AID/W central projects, but will also require your approval to be used under the project. Once you have approved the increase in buy-in funds under the project, we will amend the waiver pursuant to Federal Acquisition Regulation Subpart 6.302-3(a)(2) - the research capability exception - to exempt the buy-in requests from full and open competition. These services will be provided by delivery orders issued under the BOA.

SER/OP has reviewed a draft of the proposed waiver amendment and has advised us informally that such waiver and the amendment of the BOA are appropriate and will be approved.

RECOMMENDATION: That you sign the attached Project Data Sheet and the Project Authorization Form to increase the buy-in level from \$6,000,000 to \$9,000,000 to be contributed by missions, regional bureaus, and AID/W offices for additional country activities within the overall scope of this project.

PROJECT AUTHORIZATION

Entity: Bureau for Science and Technology
Project Title: CRSP - Soil Management

A. Pursuant to Section 103 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the centrally funded Soil Management Collaborative Research Support Program (CRSP) was authorized on September 15, 1981. It was amended on November 18, 1985 to permit the use of FY 1986 funds to complete the five-year authorized activity; on May 9, 1986 to increase the authorized life-of-project S&T Bureau funding by \$9,000,000 to \$21,850,000 to fund the project through September 30, 1990; on May 23, 1988 to approve \$6,000,000 for mission, regional bureau, and AID/W office buy-ins; and May 24, 1989 to increase the authorized life-of-project S&T Bureau funding by \$10,500,000 to \$32,350,000, and extend the final year of obligation to FY 1994 and the PACD to September 30, 1995. The project is hereby further amended as follows:

1. A new total of up to \$41,350,000 of A.I.D. appropriated funds is approved for use in this project in anticipation that regional bureaus and missions may contribute up to \$9,000,000 under various project authorities, to support project activities.

B. The authorization cited above remains in force except as herein amended.
