The purpose of this Limited Scope Grant Agreement is to provide \$50,000 in funding for the Biological Diversity/Natural Resources Profile for Sri Lanka. It comes at a time when a shared consensus among ourselves, GSL policy makers, environmental interest groups and other donors is needed as to what exactly the major problems are in the environmental and conservation sector. A profile will be put together based initially upon work recently completed around Sri Lanka. This includes the earlier Biodiversity report done by Malcolm Jansen and Eric Loken, a recent Environmental Profile done by Consultant, Malcolm Baldwin, the Central Environment Authority's lengthy National Conservation Strategy, etc. Upon our review of the National Conservation Strategy Statement of the Central Environment Authority, it is anticipated our effort would be a combination of specific research under standardized terms of reference and a translation of available sources capped off by a professional reproduction. Thus, funds will be used for items such as:

1) U.S. and/or Sri Lankan consultant services required to fill in information gaps not readily available in existing published sources and or to consolidate and reedit material already available.

2) support costs associated with the publication and printing of the Natural Resources Profile for Sri Lanka.

A second purpose of this project is to provide an additional \$9,121 in grant funding for consulting services contributing to the design of the planned Natural Resources and Environmental Policy Project (NREPP) (383-0109). This funding will be used in conjunction with funding provided under AID Project No.398-0249.10 (PD&S).
