SUBJECT: The Market and Technology Access Project (936-4053)

Problem: We request that you authorize the following increases in the funding levels for the Market and Technology Access Project: (1) an increase in the level of core grant funds from \$2,825,000 to \$4,760,000; and (2) an increase in the ceiling for buy-ins from \$3 million to \$9,975,000. Please indicate your authorization by signing the attached PAF amendment.

Discussion: The Market and Technology Access Project (MTAP) was initiated at the end of FY 83 to develop and test approaches for assisting LDC firms to establish collaborative marketing and technology ventures with small and medium U.S. firms. As the 1988 project evaluation noted, the research and field trials supported by MTAP have produced valuable lessons regarding ways of improving the cost-effectiveness of A.I.D.'s trade and investment promotion efforts. In order to pursue promising lines of inquiry and activity developed during the initial six years of MTAP, S&T/RD designed a new project component -- the Trade and Technology Initiatives Program (TTIP). The project paper amendment for TTIP was reviewed by the Rural Development Sector Council on May 18, 1989. An increase in LOP funding is needed to implement the the new set of research activities, technical services and pilot projects described in the TTIP project paper amendment. These activities will be implemented during the period from June 1, 1989 to September 30, 1993, the previously authorized PACD.

Recommendation: That you authorize an increase in LOP core grant funds for the Market and Technology Access Project from \$2,875,000 to \$4,760,000 and the ceiling for buy-ins from \$3 million to \$9.975 million by signing the attached PAF amendment.



PROJECT AUTHORIZATION (Amendment #3)

Name of Country/Entity: Worldwide
Name of Project: Market and Technology Access Project
Project Number: 936-4053

1. Pursuant to Section 103 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 as amended, the Market and Technology Access Project was authorized on May 12, 1983 for a period of five years with planned obligations not to exceed \$2,375,000 of core grant funds and up to \$3,000,000 of mission add-on funds. This authorization was amended on March 8, 1988 to increase the PACD one year to September 30, 1989, and again on June 22, 1988 to extend the PACD for four additional years through September 30, 1993 and to increase the authorized level of core funds from \$2,375,000 to \$2,825,000.

2. I hereby authorize an increase in the level of core grant funds from \$2,825,000 to \$4,760,000 and an increase in the ceiling for buy-ins from \$3 million to \$9.975 million. All other terms and conditions of the original authorization remain the same.
