SUBJECT: Amendment of the Agricultural Policy Analysis Project -
APAP (936-4084) DOC No. 408403

PROBLEM: Your approval is required to amend the authorization for the subject project to allow the obligation of Development Fund for Africa (DFA) funds within the S&T/AGR authorized life of project funding level of \$10,163,000.

DISCUSSION: The Africa Bureau has transferred \$544,000 of DFA funds from the Niger mission program to S&T/AGR to be obligated under the subject project. Technical assistance will be provided to the Government of Niger (GON) in the following priority areas identified by the mission and the GON as critical to the development of effective agricultural and rural development policy initiatives leading to the structural transformation of the rural economy.

1. Program and project design and implementation;
2. Assistance to the USAID Policy Monitoring Unit; and
3. Training of host country personnel.

A Congressional notification has been submitted to allow for the use of DFA funds (\$544,000) under this project.

RECOMMENDATION: That you approve the use of \$544,000 of DFA funds through project 936-4084 and a corresponding decrease in Section 103 funds by signing the attached PAF and Project Data Sheet.
