ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR HEALTH

SUBJECT: Amending the Water and Sanitation for Health
Project (936-5973) for use of Development Funds
for Africa (DFA)

Problem: Your Approval is needed to authorize the use of DFA funds, by the Water and Sanitation for Health Project (WASH III) Project.

Discussion: WASH III is actively involved in assisting A.I.D. missions in Africa on water supply and sanitation issues. Currently the Africa Bureau is also requesting that WASH assist the Peace Corps, through technical assistance and training, as they implement programs in four countries to control guinea worm. DFA funds will be used for these efforts; and it is anticipated that DFA funds will be required for future activities.

Recommendation: That you approve the use of funds from the Development Fund for Africa account for use by the WASH III project by signing the attached PAF amendment.
