Increase authorized LOP obligation and spending levels, for obligations up to and including FY 1990, in the amount of \$700,000 in ARDN funds. The total cost of the Project will be \$13,907,300 through 1990. The total LOP level of S&T/RD funding, in ARDN and SDA funds combined, increases from \$5,884,000 to \$6,584,000. The Peace Corps PASA covered by the increased authorization qualifies for exemption from the provision of OMB Circular A-76 Section 621(a) of the FAA.

SUBJECT: Project Authorization Amendment, Small Enterprise  
Approaches to Employment Project (931-1090) - Doc. # 0008

Problem: You are requested to authorize an increase in the core funding levels for the Small Enterprise Approaches to Employment (SEAE) project by \$700,000 in FN funds, from \$1,875,000 to \$2,575,000, to support the Peace Corps microenterprise program. This is an increase in the total LOP level of S&T/RD funding, in ARDN and SDA funds combined, from \$5,884,000 to \$6,584,000.

Discussion: The Peace Corps and the Agency for International Development (A.I.D.) have agreed that they will carry out a two-year joint program of microenterprise development. The purpose of this program is to increase the capacity of both agencies to support microenterprise development programs that will ultimately result in additional jobs and increased incomes in several target countries. Consistent with this agreement, your action is requested on the basis of the following considerations:

A. Funding Authorization: The increase of \$700,000 in total LOP SEAE funding, requested herein, is for the second year of a two-year PASA with the Peace Corps for training, coordination and related technical support in the field of microenterprise development. The funding will permit SEAE project objectives to be achieved through a mix of Peace Corps participation under the PASA and A.I.D. participation using training material and technical resources available under SEAE. The Agency Director for Human Resources approved the last increase in LOP funding for the SEAE project in August 1988, when \$400,000 in Peace Corps PASA funds for Year I were added. The two-year PASA has an expiration date of 9/30/90.

In addition, the PAF provides that funds authorized under Sections 103 and 106 of the Foreign Assistance Act may be used without regard to previously authorized dollar limits for each appropriation so long as the total authorization of \$6,584,000 for the project is not exceeded.

B. Justification for 621 (a) determination: The Justification was approved in the Action Memorandum originally approving the PASA signed August 3, 1988.

Recommendation: That you authorize the higher LOP funding levels requested herein by signing the attached PAF Amendment and Project Data Sheet.

1. Pursuant to Sections 103 and 106 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Small Enterprise Approaches to Employment project, which is centrally funded, and was originally authorized on June 29, 1978, is hereby amended as follows:

The life of project cost for core funding is increased by \$700,000 to \$6,584,000. These funds are for the second year of a PASA and related technical support for the Peace Corps for training and coordination in the field of microenterprise development.
