Pursuant to the authority of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Agency for International Development, (hereinafter referred to as "A.I.D." or "Grantor") hereby makes a Field Support Grant to the Pan American Development Foundation (hereinafter referred to as "P.A.D.F." or "Grantee") to provide support for a program to establish the National Development Foundation of Grenada (hereinafter referred to as NDFG) which will provide assistance to small business and agricultural enterprises as described in Attachment II of this Grant Agreement, entitled "Program Description" and as further described in the approved project proposal. The total estimated amount of this Grant is \$724,000 (Seven Hundred Twenty Four Thousand United States Dollars) and A.I.D. hereby grants that amount to cover program expenditures as detailed in the Program Budget in Attachment III of this Agreement.

The Grant is effective and obligation is made as of the date of this letter and shall apply to commitments made by the Grantee in furtherance of program objectives during the period September 21, 1984 to December 31, 1987.

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The Grant is made on the condition that the funds will be administered in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in Attachment I entitled "The Schedule", Attachment II entitled "Program Description", Attachment III entitled "Statement of Assurance of Compliance", and Attachment IV entitled "Standard Provisions", which have been agreed upon by your organization.

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ASSURANCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE AGENCY FOR  
INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT REGULATION UNDER TITLE VI  
OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964


Pan American Development Foundation (hereinafter call the "Grantee")

HEREBY AGREES THAT it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (P.L. 88-352) and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the Regulation of the Agency for International Development (22 CFR Part 209, 30 FR 317) issued pursuant to that title, to the end that, in accordance with Title VI of that Act and the Regulation, no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which the Grantee receives Federal financial assistance from the Agency; and HEREBY GIVES ASSURANCE THAT it will immediately take any measures necessary to effectuate this agreement.

If any real property or structure thereon is provided with the aid of Federal financial assistance extended to the Grantee by the Agency, this assurance shall obligate the Grantee, or in the case of any transfer of such property, any transferee, for the period during which the real property structure is used for a purpose for which the Federal financial assistance is extended or for another purpose involving the provision of similar services or benefits. If any personal property is so provided, this assurance shall obligate the Grantee for the period during which it retains ownership or possession of the property. In all other cases, this assurance shall obligate the Grantee for the period during which the Federal financial assistance is extended to it by the Agency.

THIS ASSURANCE is given in consideration of and for the purpose of obtaining any and all Federal grants, loans, contracts, property, discounts or other Federal financial assistance extended after the date hereof to the Grantee by the Agency, including installments payments after such date on account of applications for Federal financial assistance which were approved before such date. The Grantee recognizes and agrees that such Federal financial assistance will be extended in reliance on the representations and agreement made in this assurance, and that the United States shall have the right to seek judicial enforcement of this assurance. This assurance is binding on the Grantee, its successors, transferees, and assignees, and the person or persons whose signatures appear below are authorized to sign this assurance on behalf of the Grantee.
