

Schedule

A. Purpose of Grant:

The purpose of this Grant is to provide support for emergency relief to the severely drought affected population of the Tanout zone of Zinder Department, eastern Niger, as more specifically described in Attachment 2 to this Grant, entitled "Program Description."

B. Period of Grant:

The effective date of this Grant is November 2, 1984. The expiration date of this Grant is February 1, 1985.

C. Amount of Grant and Payment:

1. A.I.D. hereby obligates the amount of \$12,500 for purposes of this Grant.

2. Payment shall be made to the Grantee in accordance with the procedures set forth in Attachment 3, Standard Provision No. 11, entitled "Payment - Period Advance."

D. Financial Plan:

The following is the Financial Plan for this Grant, including local cost financing items. Revisions to this Plan shall be made in accordance with Standard Provision No. 9 of this Grant, entitled "Revision of Financial Plans."

E. Reporting and Evaluation:

1. CARE shall submit a one-time narrative report (five (5) copies in English and French) fully describing the use and impact of the funds provided to the Director, USAID/Niger, not later than February 15, 1985.

2. CARE shall provide a complete line-item report of expenditure according to paragraph 4 above sufficiently detailed to permit complete identification and end-use compatibility of all goods and services obtained not later than February 15, 1985 to the Controller, USAID/Niger, c/o American Embassy, B.P. 11201, Niamey, Niger.

F. Special Provision:

Standard Provisions Nos. 2, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 24, 25, 26, 27, 34, and 35 are deleted from Attachment 3, hereto.

G. Overhead Rate:

Not applicable.

H. Title to Property:

Title to all property procured under this Grant shall rest with CARE International of Niger until such time as passed to individual Nigerian Citizen Recipients excepting those items provided to the Government of Niger to permit their support of the emergency program in which case such property will be titled in the Government of Niger.

Attachment 2

Program Description

This program consists of the provision, by CARE International of Niger, of emergency medical needs, transportation and vehicle repair services to aid the distressed population of the Tanout region of Zinder Department, Niger.

Under the program, CARE will procure 90 basic pharmacy kits and 30,000 Oral Rehydration Therapy Packets for village health workers to permit immediate emergency treatment of an estimated 70,000 displaced persons in and near Tanout, Zinder Department. CARE will arrange for air shipment of the emergency material, transportation to Tanout and end-use delivery.

CARE will also arrange for basic repairs to three local health supervisor's vehicles required to monitor and assist approximately 100 village health workers providing assistance to the displaced population.
