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Mineral Resource Analysis - Thailand

I. Project Description and Purpose of This Agreement

The Royal Thai Government Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) plans to undertake an evaluation of the status of mineral resources information, programs, and institutions in Thailand, including the past inputs of foreign investment and assistance, in order to develop guidelines for future actions that may help to increase the contribution of mineral resources to Thailand's economic development. United States Government assistance has been requested to help carry out this task.

The purpose of this Agreement, therefore, is to finance a Participating Agency Service Agreement (PASA) for the services of U.S. Geological Survey Personnel to assist the RTG in implementing the project. The scope of work of the technical advisors is described in PIO/T 30123. It includes evaluation of status of information on mineral resources in Thailand, identifying exploration targets and preparation of specific recommendations for action that can be taken to accelerate resource surveys, stimulate production of minerals and increase the use of geologic data for development projects.

II. USG Participation

Pursuant to this Agreement the USG will provide up to \$50,000 for the services of two economic geologists (including one senior economic geologist as Project Chief) for a project total of up to 15 man-months, 6½ man-months of which will be spent working in Thailand. In Thailand the advisors will work directly with the Department of Mineral Resources.

III. Royal Thai Government (RTG) Participation

Pursuant to this Agreement the RTG will provide:

- A. Local support services consisting of counterpart geologists, clerical and cartographic services, office space, printing and logistical support for field studies by USGS geologists.
- B. Up to \$100,000 in Trust Funds to finance per diem and local travel for two U.S. PASA personnel for a total of 6½ man-months in Thailand.
