A. Activity Target

The joint RGA/USAID target for this activity is to gather demographic and social data which is valid for formulating population and family guidance policies in a way which will contribute to the building of a statistical capability within the RGA for the continuance of such work.

B. Course of Action

Under a contract with the State University of New York at Buffalo (SUNY), the USAID will provide assistance to the RGA in planning and conducting sample surveys of the demographic composition of the population and of the knowledge, attitude, and practice (KAP) of family planning on the part of major groups thereof. The conduct of such studies and the related development of the institutional base within the RGA for compiling demographic and KAP data will be coordinated by the National Statistical Advisory Committee under the chairmanship of the Deputy Minister of Planning.

The Committee will provide policy guidance, will assist in selecting and assigning the best available RGA manpower for participation in the activity, and will elicit needed cooperation from government Ministries. During the first six months after their arrival in Afghanistan, SUNY personnel in conjunction with the President of Statistics, Ministry of Planning, will prepare for review and approval by the Committee and USAID proposals for the organization and conduct of the surveys, including development of the RGA institutional base, and will identify the specific types and amounts of data to be included in the surveys, the nature and form of the questionnaires, the nature and method of data analysis and reporting, and schedules of implementation. The content of the KAP study will be developed using the same procedures in cooperation with and approval of the Ministry of Public Health and the Afghan Family Guidance Association. Preparation of these plans may call for revision and elaboration of this Project Agreement.

3. Commodities

Specialized technical supplies and equipment will be pro-
vided under the contract. Other supplies and equipment may be
provided only to the extent that the RGA or the USAID is unable
to provide such logistic support.

D. RGA Contributions

To the maximum extent possible, the RGA agrees to support
this joint endeavor directly and/or through the USAID Trust
Fund. This includes assigning appropriate technical and sup-
port personnel, providing needed detailed maps, transportation,
office space, facilities, equipment, and supplies and facilitating
clearances necessary for the successful achievement of the targets
of this project, both for headquarters and field activities.
