



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

A. Purpose

The purpose of this Grant is to provide a portion of the costs of preparing a summary document of a study of the effectiveness of foreign assistance to Domestic Development Services in 9 countries of Asia, Africa, and Latin America.

B. Objectives

The objectives of this Grant are to insure a) that the technical report on the effectiveness of foreign assistance to Domestic Development Services is followed up with dissemination and planning assistance, and b) that discussions are initiated among voluntary agencies and other interested agencies regarding the implementation of the conclusions and recommendations of the report.

C. Reports

On or before the expiration date of this Grant, the Grantee will present to the Office of Private and Voluntary Cooperation 15 copies of the summary report prepared under this Grant.
