PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. Project Title:

Grenada Disaster Response

2. AID Project Number:

907-0039

3. This Project Consists of:

The great fire which occurred on April 27 in St. George's, Grenada, destroyed seven buildings housing the following operations: Post Office, Finance, Treasury, Budget, Planning, Internal Revenue, Accounts, Printery and Supply Storage.

The Government of Grenada has requested assistance to return public sector employees to work. Reconstruction of records presents numerous formidable tasks that must be quickly addressed in addition to resuming normal services.

The AID funds provided under this grant will be used to restore critical government services disrupted by the fire. An advance of these funds will permit the Government of Grenada to purchase office equipment, furniture and supplies needed to resume government services and as scheduled in Annex B. The advance will be liquidated through the submission of a final statement supported by receipts for expenditures for casual labor, materials and equipment costs. Periodic visits will be made by the RDO/C Engineering Office.

4. Special Provisions:

This Disaster Relief Assistance for the Government of Grenada is being carried out pursuant to AID Handbook 8 procedures governing provision of Disaster Assistance Relief provided by the Agency for International Development for the United States Government.
