Subject: Twelve Month Planning Grant Requiring \$250,000 for Purdue
University "Planning Study - Integrated Crop Protection Research" -

Problem: Your approval is required for a \$250,000 grant to Purdue
University for a Planning Study on Integrated Crop Protection Research

Discussion: On July 6, 1979, thirty-one Title XII institutions met
and among themselves selected and ranked three institutions for
recommendation to AID/JRC as possible Integrated Crop Protection
Research planning grantees.

On July 10, 1979, the JRC met and selected one of these institutions:
namely, Purdue University for recommendation to BIFAD as the preferred
planning entity. A poll of BIFAD members by the JRC Chairman
resulted in a majority approval of the planning grantee recommendation
as proposed by JRC. AID has accepted this recommendation.

At the same JRC meeting a Statement-of-Work for the planning grant was
approved which in turn was forwarded to TPCA for discussion at the
August 17, 1979 meeting, where it was approved. This Statement-of-Work
constituted a two phased grant with the second phase conditional
on the results from the first phase and only to be started if relevant
research addressing the needs of small farm cropping systems in
the LDCs can be identified (as a distinct possibility).

The TPCA approved the substantive elements discussed in Phase I of the
JRC approved Statement-of-Work but did not consider any of the elements
of Phase II. Since Phase I of the JRC approved planning grant Statement-
of-Work represents a plan for a complete and definitive product and
provides a clearly defined decision point for either further planning
or for project abandonment, the Office of Agriculture has elected to
fund a planning study only to this extent. The attached Statement-of-
Work reflects the above mentioned approach.

Careful consideration of the various budgetary aspects for the planning
envisioned in the attached Statement-of-Work clearly show that the
entire sum budgeted for ICP planning in FY 79 will be required for this
type of planning.

The product of this grant will be an assessment document containing sufficient information for AID/JRC to evaluate the need for and identify mechanisms for mounting an Integrated Crop Protection Research Program.

AID received a planning grant pre-proposal from Purdue University on August 24, 1979 which details necessary budgets, milestones and reporting operations associated with the AID/JRC developed Statement-of-Work.

The activities of this Planning Study for Integrated Crop Protection Research will result in: 1) a description of the crop protection problem situation in developing countries; 2) a state-of-the-art summary document; 3) identification of research activities suitable for execution through Title XII universities and beneficial to LDCs; and 4) a recommendation for or against such research and a description of the potential approaches which might be used in addressing the problem.

Recommendation: That you approve the twelve month grant request requiring funds of \$250,000 for the subject project by signing the PAF attached herein.
