

- (b) The Project Assistance Completion Date is December 31, 1989.





ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR HEALTH

SUBJECT: Extend Project Assistance Completion Date (PACD) for Diarrheal Disease Research (936-5928)

Problem: Your approval is requested to extend the PACD of the Diarrheal Disease Research Project which was authorized in FY 1984, and includes a grant to the Diarrheal Disease Control Program of the World Health Organization (DDC/WHO), and a cooperative agreement with the International Center for Diarrheal Disease Research at Bangladesh (ICDDR,B).

Discussion: The large number of diarrheal diseases caused by hundreds of agents constitute a continuing threat to the life and well-being of children throughout the world, causing an estimated 5 million deaths and one billion episodes of diarrhea each year. Current global efforts can only reduce the mortality associated with dehydration from acute diarrheal disease. Recent developments in biotechnology, however, offer an opportunity to prevent diarrheal diseases and treat the actual cause of disease. This would have a marked impact on the growth and development of children in the developing world, including the United States.

Both the Diarrheal Disease Control Program of the World Health Organization (WHO/CDD) and the International Center for Diarrheal Disease Research, Bangladesh (ICDDR,B) have shown exemplary efforts in global research in the areas of diarrheal diseases etiology, epidemiology and vaccine development. WHO/CDD is currently the largest and best known integrated diarrheal disease control research and training program in the world. A.I.D. has been providing support for both ICDDR,B and WHO/CDD. In order to provide continuation of current ongoing activities on the diarrheal disease control program and vaccine development to combat the leading cause of infant and child mortality and morbidity, an amendment to this project is required to extend the PACD to December 31, 1989 while a new follow-on cooperative agreement is anticipated.

Recommendation: That you approve the extension of the Project Assistance Completion Date from December 31, 1988 to December 31, 1989 by signing the attached amended project authorization.
