ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR HUMAN RESOURCES

SUBJECT: Modification of Cooperative Agreement with the University of Wisconsin Land Tenure Center and the Research on Access to Land, Water, and Natural Resources (ACCESS), Project #936-5301

Problem: Your approval is requested to raise the S&T core funding ceiling under the ACCESS project and the cooperative agreement with the Land Tenure Center (LTC) by \$350,000 in order to assure institutional and programmatic continuity before the start of the planned ACCESS II project.

Discussion: In April 1988, LTC received incremental funding from S&T to support its core research program through January 19, 1989. We had hoped that by this time, the proposed ACCESS II project would have been approved and a new cooperative agreement negotiated between A.I.D. and LTC. This has not proven to be the case, and our best estimates now are that a new cooperative agreement will be in place by the spring of 1989. Unfortunately, by mid-January 1989, the core funding of LTC under its cooperative agreement with S&T will have been virtually exhausted. If not provided with bridge funding, LTC and the ACCESS project will be faced with the prospect of a four-to six-month hiatus in funding, which would seriously disrupt on-going work and most likely result in the immediate loss of needed personnel. Thus, in order to ensure that on-going research activities are continued until their completion at the project's PACD in July 1989 and to maintain LTC's institutional capacity to implement ACCESS II, we will need to raise S&T's core funding ceiling under the cooperative agreement by \$350,000. This amount will come from funds previously slated for ACCESS II start-up, since ACCESS II will now be starting later than we had previously estimated.

With your approval of our request: (a) the S&T core funding ceiling under the cooperative agreement will be raised from \$3,389,835 to \$3,739,835; (b) the authorized ceiling on the project's core funding will be increased from \$6,167,277 to \$6,517,277; (c) the total cooperative agreement ceiling will be

increased from \$7,090,737 to \$7,440,737 (\$3,739,835 core and \$3,700,902 regional bureau and mission buy-ins); and (d) the project's total LOP funding level will be increased from \$14,789,000 to \$15,139,000 (\$6,517,277 core and \$8,621,723 regional bureau and mission buy-ins).

Recommendation: That you: (1) approve the increase in core funding ceiling of the ACCESS project and the cooperative agreement with LTC by \$350,000; and (2) sign the attached project authorization amendment.

## Project Authorization Amendment

Name of Country/Entity: Worldwide  
Name of Project: Research on Access to Land, Water,  
and Natural Resources  
Number of Project: 936-5301

1. Pursuant to Section 103 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the "ACCESS" project was authorized on August 8, 1979. The authorization was last amended on September 22, 1988, to: (a) raise the S&T core funding ceiling from \$6,150,000 to \$6,167,277; and (b) reduce the authorized ceiling on regional bureau and mission incremental funding from \$8,639,000 to \$8,621,723. The total cooperative agreement ceiling and the project's total LOP level remained unchanged at \$7,090,737 and \$14,789,000, respectively. That authorization is hereby amended as follows:

a. The S&T core funding ceiling under the cooperative agreement is raised from \$3,389,835 to \$3,739,835.

b. The authorized ceiling on the project's core funding is increased from \$6,167,277 to \$6,517,277.

c. The total cooperative agreement ceiling is increased from \$7,090,737 to \$7,440,737 (\$3,739,835 core and \$3,700,902 regional bureau and mission buy-ins).

d. The project's total LOP level is increased from \$14,789,000 to \$15,139,000 (\$6,517,277 core and \$8,621,723 regional bureau and mission buy-ins).

2. The authorization cited above remains in force except as hereby agreed.

3. Source and origin of goods and services:

a. Each developing country where training or other assistance takes place under this project shall be deemed to be a cooperating country for the purpose of permitting local cost funding.

b. Goods and services, except for ocean shipping, financed by A.I.D under the project shall have their source and origin in a cooperating country or in the United States except as A.I.D may otherwise agree in writing.

c. Ocean shipping financed by A.I.D. under the project shall, except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing, be financed only on flag vessels of the United States.
