BACKGROUND

The Tholana village with a population of 150 has developed a 100 acre area with coconut trees. This activity began in the early 1970's. They have continued to expand and improve the coconut plantation and have just acquired an additional 10 acres suitable for coconuts.

DISCUSSION

The copra demand has been met in the village of Tholana. There are income generation opportunities for Tholana Village if they can transport their copra to the buying center in Buala.

SOLUTION:

The Village has adequate canoes to transport the copra, however without motorized transport, the transport of copra is both time and labor consuming. This grant will enable the Tholana Community to purchase a 25HP engine to expedite their copra delivery.

PERIOD OF AGREEMENT:

The expiration date of this agreement is July 1, 1990.

**AMOUNT OF GRANT:**


The Government of the Solomon Islands agrees to disburse to the beneficiary an equivalent in Solomon Islands dollars not to exceed \$US2,300.

Payment shall be made to the grantee in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Grant Agreement.


