

1. Pursuant to Section 103 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, I hereby authorize the U.S. Agricultural Development Corporation Project involving planned obligations not to exceed One Hundred and Fifty Thousand U.S. Dollars (\$150,000) over a two year period from the date of authorization, subject to the availability of funds in accordance with the A.I.D./OYB/allotment process. First year (FY 1986) obligation will be One Hundred and Fifty Thousand U.S. Dollars (\$150,000).
2. The project consists of a refundable grant to finance several feasibility studies for prospective agricultural and agri-business ventures in selected A.I.D.-recipient countries. The goal of the project is to foster the growth of productive self-sustaining, job-producing indigenous private enterprise in developing countries. The purpose is to bring U.S. agricultural expertise, technology and capital together with local investors to advance private sector agriculture in developing countries.

- 3. Any grants or contracts under this project, which may be negotiated and executed by the officer(s) to whom such authority is delegated in accordance with A.I.D. regulations and Delegation of Authority, shall be subject to the following essential terms, covenants and major conditions, together with such other terms and conditions as A.I.D. may deem appropriate:

Source and Origin of Goods and Services. Goods and Services financed by A.I.D. under this grant shall have their source and origin in the United States, the host country or A.I.D. Geographic Code 941 Countries, except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing. Ocean shipping financed by A.I.D. under this project shall, except as A.I.D. may agree otherwise in writing, be financed only on flag vessels of the United States.
