I. Purpose

In support of the work of both the Accelerated Cereals Production Program (detailed in the Project Agreement for Project 664-11-130-205, dated August 31, 1969) and the GOT's program for livestock improvement through the provision of quality forage and feedgrain supplies, funds will be provided to the Accelerated Cereals Production Project of the Ministry of Agriculture in order to engage the services of an Extension Specialist and to procure limited commodities for a farm demonstration and evaluation program in corn, sorghum, sunflowers and certain leguminous crops.

A. The technician in charge, in addition to conducting a farm demonstration program for these crops, will develop, with the assistance of other ACPD technicians, technical guides and cultural practices to be followed in the growing of corn, sorghum and sunflowers for forage and feedgrain purposes. In addition, the technician will assist in on-the-job training of Tunisian technicians and farmers in the growing and processing of the specified crops for silage, soilage, stover and grain purposes. The technician also will prepare cropping plans and progress reports and assist ACPD and extension service personnel with other tasks as assigned by his supervisor, the Director of the Accelerated Cereals Production Project (ACPD).

B. Limited commodity support for the demonstration activities of the technician and his supporting staff will consist of locally available seed, fertilizer, herbicides and pesticides, miscellaneous items and services and two utility vehicles to meet the extensive and daily transportation requirements of the program. The Accelerated Cereals Production Project will provide office space and services, supplies, and vehicle maintenance for the technician.

C. A counterpart to the project leader of an Ingenieur grade and an adjoint technique will be assigned to and trained by the technician. He is required to create a Tunisian team that is capable of replacing him at the earliest opportunity.
