

ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE ACTING AGENCY DIRECTOR FOR HEALTH

SUBJECT: Project authorization amendment for the Health  
Resource Support (936-5929) Project

PROBLEM: The centrally-funded Health Resource Support (936-5929) Project was authorized on May 30, 1984. That authorization was amended on April 28, 1985, December 29, 1985, May 5, 1988, September 21, 1989, and September 19, 1990. Your authorization is requested to amend the project as specified below:

- a. Authorize funds in the amount of \$200,000 for FY 91 and \$200,000 for FY 92 to provide assistance to children orphaned or displaced through natural or man made disasters.
- b. Authorize a three-year, \$600,000 Grant to the National Council for International Health to support their annual International Health Conferences.
- c. Extend the PACD from October 30, 1993 to November 30, 1994.

DISCUSSION: The purpose of this project is to improve the design, development, implementation, management, and evaluation of health, AIDS, and child survival projects and programs for Less Developed Countries (LDCs). To achieve this goal, technical assistance to S&T/Health and the A.I.D. Regional Bureaus is provided through various contracting mechanisms, and funds are provided to support international health conferences, workshops and meetings.

We now wish to amend this project to authorize up to \$200,000 in funds for FY 91 and \$200,000 for FY 92 to provide assistance to children orphaned or displaced through natural or man made disasters.

Beginning in 1991, S&T/H will have the responsibility for coordinating the Agency's work with displaced children. Funds will be used for planning and evaluation. Planning will involve sending technical experts to various countries to assist relevant organizations to identify problems and solutions to the problems of displaced and orphaned children. In some cases local experts may also be hired. Evaluations will include ongoing country-specific projects plus helping S&T/H investigate problems and approaches on a worldwide basis.

We also wish to fund a three-year, \$600,000, Grant to the National Council for International Health to support their annual International Health Conferences.

For the past 17 years, the National Council for International Health has held an annual International Health Conference in the Washington metropolitan area. A.I.D. has provided support for the International Health Conference for the past 5 years. Conference attendance has grown steadily from 275 at the first annual conference in 1973, to more than 1500 during the 1988 Conference on Primary Health Care. In 1990, the Conference attracted approximately 1200 attendees, featuring about 200 presenters and 40 invited speakers.

NCIH is now requesting \$600,000 in support of the International Health Conference for the period from April, 1991 through March, 1994 to hold the International Health Conferences for 1991, 1992, and 1993, and to complete most of the planning for the 1994 Conference. The \$600,000 will support staffing for the following activities: program design; a competitive abstract program; an invited program; and the annual international health conference.

The annual International Health Conference activity which NCIH proposes would fit well with the objectives of the Health Resources Support Project, particularly in the area of meetings support. The NCIH International Health Conference provides an excellent forum for such an exchange of ideas, technical developments, trends, and international health expertise. The NCIH Conference serves several functions for the diverse group of actors in the international health community, and provides a meeting ground for representatives from A.I.D. and other major governmental and international agencies, consulting firms, and private voluntary organizations. As the Agency continues to implement a wide variety of public health projects in developing countries, it becomes more and more important to exchange ideas with other organizations, particularly private voluntary organizations, and to disseminate the lessons we have learned.

The current PACD of this project is October 30, 1993. We are requesting that the PACD be extended to November 30, 1994, which would allow NCIH to complete activities under the grant.

RECOMMENDATION:

- (1) That you approve funding in the amount of \$200,000 for FY 91 and \$200,000 for FY 92 to provide assistance to children orphaned or displaced through natural or man made disasters.
