Agreement No. 526-0642-G-SS-0005-00

Reimbursable Agreement

between

The Agency for International Development

and

The United States Information Agency

The Agency for International Development (A.I.D.) hereby enters into an agreement with the United States Information Agency (USIA) pursuant to Section 632(b) of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, subject to the terms and conditions set forth below.

1. A.I.D.

A.I.D. agrees to reimburse the USIA the sum of \$100,000 in approved costs for the purpose of furthering U.S. Government initiatives to promote democracy in Paraguay, and in particular, to assist Paraguayan efforts to improve the administration of justice in Paraguay.

2. USIA

A. Scope of work

In consideration for the funds provided by A.I.D. hereunder, USIA agrees to plan and carry out a program to expose Paraguayans active in the judicial system (i.e. judges, fiscales, public defenders, administrators, law professors) to relevant U.S. institutions, expertise and experience. The program will consist of several standard USIA activities, including but not limited to International Visitors grants, academic specialist projects, and American Participant projects. To ensure that the program is mutually supportive with other A.I.D. activities in the area of administration of justice, USIA will design the program and select the participants in consultation with A.I.D. The themes of particular interest to be addressed by the program include: constitutional reform as it relates to the judicial system, procedural reform, administrative strengthening, judicial training and the development of the judicial career, public defense systems, and methods to minimize the high degree of incarceration without sentences.

B. Receipt of Funds

A.I.D. agrees to reimburse USIA quarterly, via SF 1081, for services provided to undertake the activities envisioned in this agreement. USIA shall keep full and complete records and accounts with respect to said funds.

C. Responsibility for Funds

USIA agrees to expend the funds provided hereunder for the agreed purposes.

Estimated costs by category are as follows:

Group International Visitor Project	\$50,000.00
Two Academic Specialists Projects	\$20,000.00
Four American Participants	\$12,000.00
Consultants	\$10,000.00
Other Direct Costs	\$ 8,000.00
TOTAL	\$100,000.00

Expenditures may not exceed the amount of \$100,000 provided under this Agreement. USIA may adjust line item amounts within the grand total as may be necessary to accomplish program objectives.

D. Reports

USIA agrees to submit to the Office of the A.I.D. Representative/Paraguay quarterly reports of expenditures made against funds provided under this Agreement, and at six month intervals brief narrative progress reports to the A.I.D. Representative/Paraguay.

E. Management

USIA agrees to undertake management of the project design and development activities in accordance with its established procedures for the management of such activities, except as otherwise indicated in this Agreement or as subsequently agreed upon by the senior representatives of USIA and USAID in Paraguay.

3. General


A. Completion Date
