

b. To approve the use of DFA, ESF and AIDS funds as well as POP funds for buy-ins.


2. The authorization cited above remains in force except as hereby amended.

**ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR FOR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY**

**FROM:** S&T/POP, Duff G. Gillespie *DGG*

**SUBJECT:** Project Authorization Amendment #1 for the Family Planning Service and Technical Support Project (936-3048)

**PROBLEM:** The centrally-funded Family Planning Service and Technical Support Project (SEATS) 936-3048 was originally authorized on June 15, 1988. The authorized level is \$50,000,000 for centrally funded life-of-project and \$25,694,866 for the buy-in ceiling. The authorization only approved funding from one appropriation category, the population account. Your approval is required to add funding from a second appropriation category, the Development Fund for Africa (DFA), as specified below:

- a. the use of up to \$10,000,000 from the DFA for centrally-funded activities
- b. the use of DFA, ESF and AIDS funds, as well as POP funds for buy-ins.

There is no need to increase the authorized ceilings for either centrally-funded activities or buy-ins.

**DISCUSSION:** Since the SEATS project was approved, the Congress has mandated that an increase in A.I.D.'s support of family planning activities in Africa and provided additional resources through the DFA. The SEATS project leads in the design and expansion of national family planning programs in Africa and is an important vehicle for A.I.D.'s response to the Congressional mandate. Meetings with Africa Bureau and S&T Program Managers have determined that the most efficient way of enabling SEATS to continue support of critical population activities in Africa would be through the direct transfer of DFA funds to the Office of Population. The proposed activities fall within the scope and authorized level of the SEATS project so that there is no need to amend the current funding ceilings.
