



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Attachment A

A. Purpose

The long range objectives of this project are to determine more precisely what factors contribute to fertility change in developing nations and to what degree each factor contributes, and to present the findings in a manner that will be of greatest use for the most informed policy decisions, for national governments, international agencies and technical assistance programs.

B. Specific Objectives:

The objectives of this Grant will be accomplished in the performance of the following task and in accordance with the Grantee's proposal dated April 1979 which is incorporated by reference:

1. A thorough analytical review of research on fertility determinants and development of a research agenda for future efforts in socioeconomic analysis concerning fertility determinants.
2. An in-depth investigation of the effect of three important variables (such as education, health, and family planning program effort on fertility).
3. Investigation of problems of measurement, especially the linking of macro and micro data through the use of exploratory data analysis.
4. Case studies of conditions of fertility change in about ten countries including the measurement of relationships.
5. Consideration of the proximate determinants of fertility including such variables as age at marriage, breastfeeding, contraceptive availability and abortion.

C. Reports

The Grantee shall provide the following reports to the A.I.D. Cognizant Project Monitor during the period of the Grant:

1. Progress Reports

The Grantee will prepare semi-annual reports which detail the progress of work. At the end of the Grant period a final report summarizing project activities will be prepared. Eight copies of all reports shall be submitted to the A.I.D. Project Monitor and one copy shall be sent to the Grant Officer.

2. Task Reports

Each of the Tasks 1 through 4 in Section B, Specific Objectives will result in the production and issuance of a report. These reports shall be submitted to A.I.D. in the same manner as the semi-annual report. In addition 750 typeset copies of each task report will be prepared by the Grantee.

3. Travel Requests and Trip Reports

a. Requests for international travel will be sent to the A.I.D. Project Monitor at least one month prior to anticipated travel. Travel requests will contain the name of the traveler(s), proposed dates, duration and destination(s), as well as the purpose for the trip.

b. Trip reports for A.I.D. sponsored travel will be submitted to the A.I.D. Project Monitor in duplicate no later than 15 days after completion of the trip.

4. Financial Reports

Financial reports will be prepared and submitted to the A.I.D. Grants Officer and Project Monitor on a semi-annual basis. The summary will

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indicate expenditures to date and estimates of expenditures in the upcoming six months reporting period.

The Grantee may not exceed the amount presently obligated of \$1,235,300. Funds have been obligated to finance the first two years of the project and \$397,511 has been obligated for performance of the third year. Within the amount obligated, the Grantee may adjust line items as reasonably necessary for performance of the work. Subject to availability, additional funds in the amount of \$22,763 will be made available. The Grantee also will provide data to the Grants Officer upon request concerning costs expended or accrued by the Grantee in support of the budget information provided herein.

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E. Negotiated Overhead Rates

Pursuant to the provisions of the clause of the Standard Provisions of the Grant entitled "Negotiated Overhead Rates-Other Than Educational Institutions," a rate or rates shall be established for each of the Grantee's accounting periods during the term of the Grant.
