Dear Ms. Kruvant:

Pursuant to the authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, and the Federal Grant and Cooperative Agreement Act of 1977 (P.L. 95-224), the Agency for International Development (hereinafter referred to as "A.I.D." or Grantor") hereby further amends the above referenced Cooperative Agreement dated February 2, 1990, with Creative Associates International, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Recipient") by adding the sum of \$500,000 to finance the cost of the Recipient's assistance to implement the program of reintegration counselling of ex-combatants as a result of disarmament and demobilization and as programmatically authorized in Amendment No.5 dated March 26, 1992. This amendment also modifies the description of Reintegration Counselling.

Accordingly, the subject Cooperative Agreement is hereby amended in accordance with Attachment I, entitled "Changes to the Schedule" to reflect the addition of funds attached hereto and Attachment II "Changes in the Program Description" of the Cooperative Agreement, both attached hereto.


The addition of \$500,000, brings the total of all funds obligated under this Grant to \$5,167,500 which is the total estimated amount of assistance to be provided by A.I.D. for this program. The obligation is made as of the date of this letter and shall apply to commitments made by the Recipient in furtherance of the Project objectives through May 31, 1993.


These funds are being made available to the Recipient on the condition that the funds will be administered in accordance with the terms and conditions as set forth in Attachment 1, entitled the "Schedule", as amended, and Attachment 2, entitled "Program Description," as amended, and Attachment 3, entitled "Standard Provisions," of the above referenced Cooperative Agreement.

Except as herein amended all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.



Attachment I
Changes to the Schedule

Except as herein modified, all terms and conditions of the original Schedule remain in full force and effect.

- I. Section C., Amount of Grant and Payments, of the Schedule is amended by deleting paragraphs 1 and 2 in their entirety and substituting the following in their place:
- "1. The total estimated amount of A.I.D. contribution to this Agreement is hereby increased by \$500,000 to \$5,167,500, which will encompass a period from the effective date of this Agreement until May 31, 1993.
- "2. The amount obligated hereunder is increased by \$500,000 to a total obligated amount of \$5,167,500 for program expenditures during the period specified in B.1. above and as shown in Section E., entitled "Revised Illustrative Financial Plan."
- II. Section K., Authorized Geographic Code is amended to add the following paragraph:
- The following paragraphs are added to Section K., Authorized Geographic Code, as follows:
- "Procurement of ten (10) additional motor vehicles from Geographic Code 000, not to exceed a combined value of \$150,000, is hereby authorized under this amendment.
- Procurement of computer equipment and one electric power plant from Geographic Code 000, not to exceed a combined value of \$50,000, is hereby authorized under this amendment.
- Geographic code for Central American Common Market (CACM) applies to the procurement of some office furniture for an amount not to exceed a value of \$12,000, as per STATE 276461 and authorized WAIVER No. 519-33-90 of 9/29/1990. A new total of \$540,697 is applied to this Geographic Code.
- III. Section E., Financial Plan, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted in lieu thereof:

Attachment II
Changes to the Program Description

Except as herein modified, all terms and conditions of the original Schedule, as amended, remain in full force and effect.

I. Section B., Project Components, the Program Description is amended by deleting the paragraphs in section 11 Social/Economic Reintegration Counseling and replacing it with the following paragraphs:

"11. Social/Economic Reintegration Counseling

"The Recipient will provide, or assist in training other organizations/groups to provide, social/economic reintegration counseling and project link-up to the ex-combatants, or combatants in the process of demobilization. The purpose of this reintegration counseling is to provide ex-combatants options for participating in social and economic programs that will assist their entry into productive civilian life.

"In order to accomplish this social/economic reintegration counseling and project link-up the Recipient will carry out project activities, such as those listed below. The Recipient will collect beneficiary program needs, through counseling, and share this information with the NRS.

"The Recipient will provide management services advice to the National Reconstruction Secretariat, the C-5 (the ESAF's civilian affairs unit) and the F-16 (January 16th Foundation) or other organizations/groups representing the FMLN combatants with regards to counseling, emergency relief, integrated sustainable development project design and implementation, program linkage, and administration systems, as appropriate to accomplish the objectives of this component.

"The Recipient will provide technical assistance (TA) to all counterparts involved in the demobilization. This TA will include training of counterpart personnel or groups of combatants, in the process of demobilization, in any area of need or interest, institutional development as it pertains to ex-combatant reintegration, equipment transfer, administrative support, community organization, facilitation of access to community services, local resource identification, administrative follow-up and evaluation of implemented activities.

"The Recipient may be called upon to provide emergency

relief assistance, such as the procurement and distribution of relief supplies. In the event that this is necessary, utilizing funds from this Cooperative Agreement, the Recipient will obtain advanced written authorization from AID to procure needed relief supplies.

"The Recipient may incorporate individuals into the Recipient's DP projects, or whole communities of ex-combatants and their families into the DP projects. However, first priority should be given to reintegrating existing displaced families currently residing outside the 109 NRP municipalities, due to the limitation of the remaining funds.

"The Recipient may assist in the design of projects targeting effective reintegration of ex-combatants into longer-term activities and programs, beyond the originally proposed counseling process. It may also be involved in the implementation of such projects, only when no other qualified institution has the capacity to implement these projects. However, due to the limitation of the remaining funds under this Cooperative Agreement it is preferred that other resources be accessed for implementation longer-term activities for this population.

"The Recipient will conduct surveys, or utilize existing surveys, of ex-combatants numbers, interests, capabilities and expectations, needed to assimilate them into any project, designed specifically for them or not.

"This project component will most likely be quite dynamic, in that many outside factors, such as politics, set-backs in the demobilization process, distrust, etc., cannot be controlled by the Recipient and will impact on the Recipient's ability to implement this component. To this end, the Recipient will attempt to accomplish the activities to the best of its ability and advise A.I.D. when modifications to this project component description is warranted."
