I. PROGRAM BACKGROUND

The Cyprus-America Scholarship Program (CASP), an Agency for International Development (AID) sponsored program, was designed to strengthen the pool of trained manpower to assist Cyprus's economic and social development. This objective is being met by providing full and partial academic scholarships for Cypriot graduate and undergraduate students to attend U.S. colleges and universities to pursue degrees in development-related fields.

The program is also providing short-term technical training for mid-level professionals, in both the public and private sectors, in several areas targeted by the Cyprus Planning Bureau in accordance with the Cypriot development plan.

The program began on October 1, 1981, and will continue through September 30, 1994. It is planned that 497 full scholarship students, 335 partial scholarship students and 309 short-term participants will be trained through CASP. The program reaches both the Greek and Turkish Cypriot population, with a ratio of four Greek participants to every Turkish participant.

The focus of the program has been academic degrees due to the lack of accredited baccalaureate awarding institutions in Cyprus. Special consideration has also been given to displaced persons and needy candidates.

This report covers the period from May 1, 1992 to October 31, 1992.

II. PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

The AID CASP Program continues to wind down with the departure of forty-two scholars who completed their degrees in May and August. There are currently forty-four full and four partial scholarship students still on the Program.

This fall, AID agreed to partially fund a new academic scholar on CASP who had originally been designated to start in the fall of 1985. Kemal Demirciler was unable to accept his scholarship because of injuries he sustained in an accident. Mr. Demirciler will participate on the AID CASP scholarship until July 1994, at which time the scholarship component of the AID grant will end. He will then be transferred to the USIA sponsored CASP program to complete his degree.

The Alumni Roster project has not seen much progress over the last year. The work entailed in collecting information on CASP graduates is time consuming and often difficult. Last spring, a new staff member was hired in Cyprus specifically to troubleshoot and improve the database and information collection process. We will have an alumni update in the next bi-annual report.

In August, Janet Azer, a recent graduate from the American University in Washington, D.C. was hired to replace former Educational Assistant Kwan Ng, who left to explore new career opportunities.

Also in August, we received a visit from Mr. Daniel Hadjittofi, Executive Director of the Cyprus Fulbright Commission, who was in Washington on business with the U.S. Information Agency. Meetings with Mr. Hadjittofi included discussions about program finances, short-term training placement issues and the USIA CASP grants. AMIDEAST President, Robert Dillon, hosted a lunch for Mr. Hadjittofi attended by Kate Archambault, Program Director and Jane Mangold, Program Coordinator.

II A. Short-term Training

Forty-two short-term participants were selected for the FY92 short-term training grants, two of these were chosen by the U.S. Embassy. Thirty-nine of the participants have attended or will attend programs during this year. Three of the participants will attend programs that have been planned for 1993.

There were seven short-term participants originally chosen in 1991, of which six attended programs this year and one whose program has been postponed indefinitely.




GPA FREQUENCY CHART

Full Scholars




GPA FREQUENCY CHART

Partial Scholars





Full Scholars




ENGINEERING BREAKDOWN
