
Pursuant to the authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Agency for International Development (hereinafter referred to as "A.I.D." or "Grantor") hereby grants the Comision para Intercambio Educativo (hereby referred to as "Grantee"), the sum of \$53,000 to provide support for a program of participant training for Colombian health professionals in countries outside the United States, especially in Latin America, as described in the Schedule of this grant and the Attachment 2, entitled "Program Description."



SCHEDULE

A. Purpose of Grant

The purpose of this Grant is to provide support for the Grantee's program to assist USAID Colombia in implementing participant training activities as specifically described in Attachment 2 to this Grant entitled "Program Description."

B. Period of Grant

The effective date of this Grant is 1 July 1987. The expiration date of this Grant is 30 June 1988.

C. Amount of Grant and Payment

1. AID hereby obligates the amount of \$53,000 for purposes of this Grant.

2. Payment shall be made to the Grantee in accordance with procedures set forth in Attachment 3 Optional Standard Provision 14A, entitled "Payment-Periodic Advance." Payment requests shall be submitted to:-

D. Grant Budget

The following is the budget for this Grant, including cost financing items, if authorized. Revisions to this budget shall be made in accordance with the Standard Provisions of this Grant, entitled "Revision of Grant Budget" and subject to said provision, the Grantee is permitted to adjust between budget lines items in order to meet specified program objectives.

E. Reporting

The Grantee shall provide verbal reports, as required to the USAID Project Office and shall submit a final report which summarizes all activities completed under this Grant. The final report shall be submitted within thirty (30) days of program completion.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Fulbright Commission in Colombia will carry out a program of participant training for Colombian health professionals in countries outside the U.S. especially in Latin America. As part of the program, the Commission: (a) will receive applications for training from such personnel; (b) will review programs and training requested, as well as background and qualifications of the applicants, including language capability, if appropriate; (c) based on such review, will make recommendations to appropriate Embassy officials (AID Office) regarding approval of such candidates and training; (d) if approval is provided, will implement arrangements for such training, including arranging transportation; (e) will oversee the participation of Colombians in such training; and (f) conduct appropriate follow-up activities after training is completed. In carrying out these tasks, the Commission will utilize norms and methodologies developed in its handling of AID-funded participants training programs (in the States).

It is anticipated that the great majority of participants will receive short-term, intensive (up to three months) training, which may include attendance at seminars and workshops. It is anticipated that approximately 20 Colombian health professionals and other personnel will receive such training through this program.

The Fulbright Commission will furnish facilities for administration of the program. Administrative costs for the program are included in the budget.
