GOAL: To improve the living conditions of targeted populations in Hungary

1. SHIPPING OF \$10 MILLION OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES TO TARGETED INSTITUTIONS AND POPULATIONS THROUGH A SERIES OF SUBGRANTS.

Two containers were sent to Hungary (10-8-92 and 10-28-92) with a total value of \$840,406.31. There was also a shipment of interocular lenses sent on 10-15-92 with a value of \$135,900.00. This quarter has a total in-kind value of \$976,306.31.

2. DEVELOP EFFECTIVE SYSTEM TO ENSURE ON-GOING DELIVERY OF COMMODITIES TO TARGETED INSTITUTIONS.

The delivery system in Hungary is progressing and still working very well.

3. IMPROVE AND STANDARDIZE LEVEL OF CARE TO TARGET POPULATIONS.

As before, the influx of refugees from the former Yugoslavia has put a strain on the already limited availability of disposable medical supplies. In turn, BBF continues to work on fulfilling their need for medical supplies/equipment and pharmaceuticals.

4. SUPPORT AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM TO INCREASE SENSITIVITY AND AWARENESS.

A. The project to produce patient information pamphlets is continuing as planned with hopes to print soon.

B. The public education program is also progressing. Because this training course will cost less to produce than expected, Soros Foundation will be able to put more of the funds toward the patient information pamphlets.
