

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

A. Purpose

The purpose of this Grant is to provide funds to the Grantee to support a conference on constitutionlism and democracy. The grants funds of \$33,000 are to cover the travel, lodging and one-fourth of the administrative costs of ten participants from seven developing nations.

B. Objective

The conference will foster an exchange of information and views among leaders and influential observers about contemporary issues of constitutional govern-ment and will convey American and Western values by describing the fundamental philosophy incorporated in the U.S. constitution that has helped shape the United States political system and promote adherence to civil and political rights by increasing knowledge and information on constitutions.

C. Implementation

The Grantee will implement the conference as described in their proposal letter dated April 8, 1982, which is hereby incorporated as part of this Grant by reference.

D. Budget

The funds herein shall be used to finance the following items:

AID funds for this effort shall not exceed the budget amount of \$33,000. Other costs will be covered by a grant from ICA and the Grantee's own resources.
