

SCHEDULE

A. Purpose of Grant

The purpose of this grant is to provide support for Grantee's development education program, as more specifically described in Enclosure 2 to this grant entitled "Program Description" and the Grantee's proposal which is incorporated herein by reference. In the event of an inconsistency between the Grantee's proposal, the program description, and this Schedule, the Schedule and then the Program Description shall take precedence.

B. Period of Grant

1. The effective date of this grant is August 24, 1987. The expiration date of this grant is August 23, 1990.

2. Funds obligated hereunder are available for program expenditures from the period from August 24, 1987 to August 23, 1988 as shown in D. below.

3. Upon Grantee's successful demonstration of its fund raising capabilities, A.I.D. may provide additional funding in support of this educational development project.

C. Method of Payment and Amount of Grant

1. The total estimated amount of this grant for the period shown in B.1. above is \$248,784.

2. A.I.D. hereby obligates the amount of \$79,602 for program expenditures during the period set forth in B.2. above and as shown in D. below.

3. Payment shall be made to the Grantee in accordance with procedures set forth in Attachment 4, Optional Standard Provision No. 2., entitled "Payment - Periodic Advance".

D. Budget

The following is the Budget for this grant, including local cost financing items, if authorized. Revisions to this Plan shall be made in accordance with the Standard Provision of this grant, entitled "Revision of Budget".

E. Reporting and Evaluation

The Grantee shall prepare and submit to the A.I.D. Project Officer annual program reports not later than 90 days prior to the anniversary date of this grant. The reports shall reflect progress made in achieving goals and objectives as specified in the Program Description and work plan.

Specifically, the report shall include:

1. A narrative description of work undertaken during the grant period which compares actual accomplishments to the goals and objectives established in the grant agreement.
2. Revised work plan, if necessary, with justification of proposed changes.
3. A list of scheduled activities which have occurred or are planned in the near term.
4. Two copies of any materials which have been produced under this grant (i.e., brochures, curriculum guides, fact sheets, etc.) and one copy of any visual aids (i.e., slide tape presentations, videos, etc.).
5. A detailed pipeline analysis of financial expenditures for the grant period which identifies disbursements by expense category.

The final report/evaluation shall be submitted not later than 30 days after the expiration date of the grant and shall include a summary analysis of project activity and statement of lessons learned. The final evaluation shall also include an assessment of the overall impact of the project on the target audience, the Grantee's own institution, and other pertinent groups.

F. Title of Property

Title to all property purchased under this grant shall be vested in the Grantee and subject to the Standard Provisions entitled "Title to Property - Grantee".

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Grantee is a non-governmental resource organization for American and foreign youth service agencies and youth workers. AYWC's mission is to provide information, training, technical assistance and staff exchange programs to domestic, foreign and international youth organizations, national or regional coalitions, community-based organizations, governmental units and others committed to developing effective, innovative services for youth. Children's Express and Youth Communications are organizations which provide opportunities for youth journalists to learn and practice their skills.

The project funded under this grant, entitled "A Development Educational Program for Young People: Youth Speak to Youth and the Youth Service", is aimed at two target groups: (1) 600 youth -- age 18 and under -- who write for youth newspapers and (2) youth who are served by 3,000 community based youth service agencies. Goals for this project include:

1. Increased awareness among American youth and youth service agencies of critical Third World issues.
2. Development by youth and adults of a specialized program in poverty, hunger, homelessness and other issues for use by American youth and service agencies.
3. Participation and joint collaboration of new private organizations in educating American youth and the youth service about Third World issues, and
4. Integration of development education into the on-going activities of youth news organizations and youth service agencies in the U.S. and publication of general circulation stories by American young people about youth and youth-related issues in the Third World.

Project outcomes anticipated include:

- curriculum and information materials,
- formal pairings of American and Third World youth service agencies,
- news releases and articles for youth-written newspapers,
- conferences on development education for young people,
- presentations at national conferences for youth workers,
- a speakers bureau,
- a "Development Education Guide for the Student Press",
- interviews of national and international leaders by young journalists,
- issues forums conducted by young people, and
- nationally distributed radio shows produced by young people.
