PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This grant to the Community Nutrition Institute in support of the National Committee for World Food Day will enable the Committee to complete its 1982 program as activities are reaching their peak. These activities directly support the work of the Agency for International Development through the mandate contained in the Biden-Pell Amendment that A.I.D. should inform Americans of the food needs of people in the developing world and encourage public discussion of the role of development assistance and food aid provided by the United States. The Committee represents the combined support of 262 national and regional organizations for this mandate as expressed through World Food Day.

The grant will help generate the public response that both the Congress and A.I.D. want to achieve. The Grantee will work together with A.I.D. and community and university organizers to develop cooperation toward this goal with emphasis on world food education/information at the community level.

In-kind support will be provided by other organizations, including rent, telephone, postage and staff support.
