- (b) The Pragma Corporation, hereafter referred to as the subcontractor, agrees and acknowledges as follows:
 - (1) That it will, for and on behalf of the SBA, fulfill and perform all of the requirements of Contract No. PDC-0230-C-00-6160-00 for the consideration stated therein and that it has read and is familiar with each and every part of the contract.
 - (2) That the SBA has delegated responsibility for the administration of this subcontract to AID with complete authority to take any action on behalf of the Government under the terms and conditions of this subcontract.

SECTION B - SERVICES AND PRICES

B.1 Services

The Contractor will, on behalf of the Office of Private and Voluntary Cooperation, plan, design and implement a conference for the Project Directors of the Biden-Pell/Development Education program grants. The conference will take place over a 3 to 4 day period in early November somewhere in the vicinity of Annapolis, Maryland. The objective of this conference is to provide an opportunity for grantees and A.I.D. officials to share program experiences, identify lessons learned and to collaborate on future programming opportunities.

B.2 Price and Payment

For satisfactory performance of the services described above, and more fully in SECTION C, the Contractor shall be paid the firm fixed price of thirty-six thousand seven hundred and four dollars (\$36,704).

Contractor shall submit a single invoice upon completion of the work, which is defined as submittal of the final report of the conference proceedings. This modifies FAR 52.232-1, PAYMENTS (APRIL 1984), concerning payment due date.

SECTION C - WORK STATEMENT

C.1 Background

Since FY 1981, A.I.D. has been implementing a Development Education grant program as authorized by the Biden-Pell Amendment to the International Security and Development Cooperation Act of 1980. Over 50 domestic and international organizations have been funded over the past four years to implement a variety of education programs geared to a broad cross-section of the American public.

In 1984, A.I.D. hosted the first Biden-Pell workshop for project directors in Harpers Ferry, West Virginia. This was the first time A.I.D. officials and A.I.D. grantees had the opportunity to meet as a group, share project experiences, materials and resources, as well as clarify program policies and objectives. The workshop was acclaimed by all as a very worthwhile experience which promoted better communication, collaboration and team building. Pleased by the success of

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the first workshop, the Office of Private and Voluntary Cooperation sponsored an expanded conference the following year and opened it to any interested party from the development education community. This conference was held in Annapolis, Maryland and was attended by approximately one hundred people. Again, participants found the workshop educational and a good opportunity to share and become updated on various program issues and initiatives.

The initial plan for this year's conference will be similar to the format of last year's model. A.I.D. plans to hold the meeting in Annapolis again and open it to interested members of the development education community. Due to the attention gained by last year's program and the increased number of organizations becoming involved in Development Education, AID expects approximately 150 participants to attend this year's session. As there continues to be business and concerns particular to A.I.D. and the Biden-Pell grantees, A.I.D. plans to reserve the first day for a "closed" session which will again take the form of a pre-conference workshop.

C.2 Scope of Work

The Contractor will provide a project manager, conference facilitator, and the support staff necessary to run a conference for 100 to 150 participants from PVOs and A.I.D. for a three to four day period. The participants will be coming from various locations in the United States. The duties and responsibilities of the Contractor include the following:

1. Locate, negotiate and reserve a suitable conference site within a 50 mile radius of Washington, D.C. It is expected that this will be in the vicinity of Annapolis, Maryland. (Note: the attendees will be responsible for their own room and board charges. The Contractor will cover conference facilities, equipment rental and other related costs.);
2. Handle pre-registration, registration and correspondence with grantees prior to the workshop;
3. Develop a questionnaire to elicit input from the project directors for the conference agenda. Follow-up with individual consultations with project directors, A.I.D. officials and program specialists as needed;
4. Finalize the conference agenda, pre-conference mailings and handout materials;

5. Schedule and coordinate attendees transportation to conference site;
6. Identify, invite and orient guest speakers, group leaders and resource persons. Make arrangements with invited speakers to cover travel and per diem;
7. Provide a conference facilitator to head, motivate and stimulate conference sessions. The facilitator will have the lead responsibility for the conference format;
8. Provide a manager and assistant to handle logistics and ensure the smooth functioning of activities during the conference;
9. Welcome, check-in and orient attendees. Provide schedules and distribute workshop materials;
10. Develop and analyze conference evaluation questionnaire;
11. Provide a writer who has expertise in the area of Development Education to compile and write a final report reflecting the state-of-the-art of this program area at this time. Additionally, the contractor will print 200 final copies of this report;
12. Provide editing services necessary to produce a "publication quality," camera-ready copy of the final report.

C.3 Required Products/Reports

The Contractor will provide to A.I.D. the written end products/reports listed below:

1. A time phased work plan within seven working days of contract authorization. Comments on the work plan will be given to the Contractor within three working days of receipt by A.I.D.;
2. A questionnaire and draft agenda designed to elicit comment/input from conference attendees;
3. A conference announcement and pre-registration form;
4. A list of conference attendees with organizational affiliation, addresses and phone numbers (to be distributed at conference);
5. A final agenda;

6. An evaluation instrument;
7. A draft report of the conference proceedings including an analysis of evaluation feedback within 20 days after the workshop;
8. A final report of the conference five days after receipt of A.I.D. comments.

C.4 Technical Directions

Performance of the work hereunder shall be subject to the technical directions of the cognizant A.I.D. Project Officer. As used herein, "Technical Directions" are directions to the Contractor which fill in details, suggest possible lines of inquiry, or otherwise complete the general scope of the work. "Technical Directions" must be within the terms of this contract, shall not change or modify them in any way, and shall not constitute changes (as described in the clause of this contract entitled, "Changes - Fixed Price - Alternate I") (FAR 52.243-01), which may only be accomplished by the Contracting Officer. The Contractor shall comply with the clause of this contract entitled, "Notification of Changes" (FAR 52.243-07).
