GOAL: To improve the living conditions of targeted populations in Hungary

1. SHIPPING OF \$10 MILLION OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES TO TARGETED INSTITUTIONS AND POPULATIONS THROUGH A SERIES OF SUBGRANTS.

In this quarter, Brother's Brother Foundation had two containers scheduled for Hungary in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Health. However, the quality of the supplies and equipment available did not meet with our expectations for use in Hungary. Therefore, we canceled the containers and are planning to ship a container within the next month.

2. DEVELOP EFFECTIVE SYSTEM TO ENSURE ON-GOING DELIVERY OF COMMODITIES TO TARGETED INSTITUTIONS.

3. IMPROVE AND STANDARDIZE LEVEL OF CARE TO TARGET POPULATIONS.

As before, the influx of refugees from the former Yugoslavia has put a strain on the already limited availability of disposable medical supplies. In turn, BBF continues to work on fulfilling their need for medical supplies/equipment and pharmaceuticals.

4. SUPPORT AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM TO INCREASE SENSITIVITY AND AWARENESS.

The Health Education Program in Hungary continues to be successful in training several thousand teachers in their workshops. These workshops introduce five part Health Curriculum including drugs, alcohol, smoking prevention, human sexuality and AIDS, and nutrition.

As I previously reported, the teacher training workshops have focused on innovative methodology which can be applied to other subjects in the school curriculum, eventually involving over one thousand students and their families.

1. SHIPPING OF \$4 MILLION OF COMMODITIES TO TARGETED POPULATIONS AND INSTITUTIONS.

Brother's Brother Foundation did not ship a medical container to Romania in this quarter. However, after corresponding with Father Grabowski, we were able to establish relations with the new consignee and schedule for a container to be loaded at our warehouse on October 20, 1993.

2. DEVELOP EFFECTIVE DELIVERY SYSTEM.

Father Grabowski has been traveling to Romania to establish an effective distribution system within the hospitals and orphanages. He will be returning to Romania at the time the container will be arriving in Constanza.

3. STRENGTHEN TIES WITH BBF, ROEA, AND ROMANIAN CHURCH.

In working to establish a new distribution system and schedule for another container, the relationship between BBF, ROEA, and the Romanian Church has been strengthened.

4. PROVIDES GOODS AND SERVICES TO REHABILITATE TEN ORPHANAGES AND TEN HOMES FOR THE ELDERLY.

The estimated arrival date for the container in Costanza is November 30, 1993. The medical and educational supplies shipped over to Romania will be distributed to hospitals and orphanages throughout Constanza and Bucharest.

5. IMPROVE AND STANDARDIZE CARE.

BBF will continue to collect the needed medical supplies and equipment for future shipments to Romania.




