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**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

From June 29 to July 9, 1992, Mr. Joanny Kaboré, INTRAH Resident Consultant in Burkina Faso, conducted a MCH refresher workshop in Ouagadougou for 16 national FP trainers and 5 resource persons and tested the draft MCH refresher curriculum for physicians, nurses and midwives. Two national trainers were unable to participate in the workshop because of previous commitments.

**Major accomplishments included:**

- An MCH refresher was conducted for 16 national trainers and 5 resource persons. The Directorate of Family Health (DSF) expects these persons to act as resources to provincial trainers during refresher MCH workshops.
- Participants recommended revisions to the draft MCH refresher curriculum for physicians, midwives and nurses.
- Participants were oriented to the MOH's expectations for MCH services, as stated in the national MCH/FP service policies and standards.

**Major recommendations included:**

- MCH resource persons who participated in this activity should be trained in training methodologies to strengthen national MCH training capability.
- MCH reference documents should be provided to national and provincial trainers and to MCH service providers and service supervisors.

**SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES**

**I. PURPOSE OF ACTIVITY**

The purpose of the activity was to conduct a MCH refresher workshop for national trainers and resource persons and test the draft MCH refresher training curriculum for physicians, nurses and midwives.

**II. ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

- A. An MCH refresher was conducted for 16 national trainers and 5 resource persons. The DSF expects these persons to act as resources to provincial trainers during refresher MCH workshops. Content areas included pre-conceptual consultation, post-natal and post-partum consultation, high-level decontamination and disinfection, the management of supplies and contraceptive stock.
- B. Participants recommended revisions to the draft MCH refresher curriculum for physicians, midwives and nurses.
- C. Participants were oriented to the MOH's expectations for MCH services, as stated in the national MCH/FP service policies and standards.

**III. BACKGROUND**

In February 1992 an INTRAH-assisted inventory of needs and available resources for the development of a MCH curriculum for physicians, midwives and nurses was conducted as part of the INTRAH/DSF PAC I Ib project (see Trip Report B-#235). Based on findings and recommendations from the inventory, a MCH refresher curriculum was prepared in March/April 1992 (see Trip Report B-#236). The activity described in this report was designed to update the MCH knowledge of national trainers and to pre-test the curriculum. The curriculum is scheduled to be finalized in October 1992.

#### IV. DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES

##### A. Preparation

Mr. Kaboré prepared for the workshop with national trainers Mrs. Thérèse Yugma and Mrs. Suzanne Soma from May 1-3, 1992. They agreed on objectives, a schedule and workshop methodology. They also agreed that 5 resource persons with extensive experience in MCH service delivery and supervision would be invited to attend the workshop and assist with recommending revisions to the curriculum. (The names of the MCH resource persons have an asterisk (\*) in Appendix A.)

##### B. Workshop

The workshop was held from June 29-July 9, 1992. The sessions conducted on June 29 by Dr. Germain Traore, Mrs. Franceline Ilboudo and Mr. Kaboré were devoted to orienting participants to workshop objectives, curriculum objectives in relation to findings and recommendations from the February 1992 activity to inventory needs and available resources for developing an MCH refresher curriculum, and the relationship between the content of the curriculum and the national MCH/FP Service Policy and Standards document.

From June 30 to July 9, individual reading and small group discussions followed by plenary debates focused on answering the following questions for each module in the draft curriculum:

- a. Does the module include new practices?

If the answer is "yes", what are they and are they scientifically justified?

- b. Are the objectives in the module clearly stated and are they measurable and does the content reflect the objective?

If the answer is "no", indicate how the objectives and content should be improved.

- c. Are the methodologies participatory?

If the answer is "no", indicate how the methodologies should be improved.

- d. Is the module consistent with the national MCH/FP service policy and standards?

If the answer is "no", what should be done so there is consistency?

- e. Does the module respond to needs identified in February 1992?

As each module was discussed and decisions were made, 2 reporters noted the modifications to be made during curriculum revision and finalization.

## V. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

### 1. Finding

The national team of trainers does not have the skills necessary to conduct refresher MCH training.

#### Recommendations

The national training team should include the MCH resource persons who participated in this activity. These persons should be trained in training methodologies to strengthen their capability to assist provincial trainers to carry out refresher MCH training.

Provincial trainers should be oriented to the use of the MCH refresher curriculum. The DSF should develop a system to allow national trainers to provide training support to provincial trainers and allow MCH resource persons to act as technical resources.

### 2. Findings

Only a few MCH reference documents are available in the provinces.

Most of the provinces do not have facilities to reproduce materials.

**Recommendations**

The DSF, in collaboration with USAID/Washington cooperating agencies and other donors, should provide MCH reference documents to each province.

The DSF should assist the provinces to reproduce materials for a broader distribution.
