

Dear Ms. Van Rynbach:

Pursuant to the authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Agency for International Development (hereinafter referred to as "A.I.D." or "Grantor") hereby grants to Save the Children (USA) (hereinafter referred to as "SCF" or "Grantee") disaster assistance in the form of commodities to provide support for its disaster assistance program, as described in the Schedule and the Program Description of this grant.

This grant is effective as of May 16, 1991. These commodities shall be used by the Grantee in furtherance of disaster assistance objectives during the period beginning with the effective date and ending on the estimated completion date of August 15, 1991.

This grant is made to SCF on condition that the commodities will be administered in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in Attachment 1, entitled "Schedule", Attachment 2, entitled "Program Description", Attachment 3, entitled "Standard Provisions", which have been agreed to by your organization.

ATTACHMENT 1

SCHEDULE

A. Purpose of Grant

The purpose of this Grant is to provide commodity support for disaster assistance, as more specifically described in the Attachment 2 to this Grant entitled "Program Description."

B. Period of Grant

The effective date of this Grant is May 16, 1991. The expiration date of this Grant is August 15, 1991.

C. Commodities

1. The following commodities will be used exclusively for cyclone disaster relief, as described in the Program Description (Attachment 2). The Grantee will immediately distribute these commodities to ensure effective use in meeting the needs of disaster victims.

2. A.I.D. hereby grants the commodities listed above, valued at approximately US\$30,000 for the purposes of this Grant. No cash funds are granted under this agreement.

D. Reporting and Evaluation

1. As stated in Attachment 2, Section C, the Grantee is required to monitor the use of supplies provided under this Grant and to document/account for their disposition in accordance with its standard practices and procedures, to the extent practicable under emergency circumstances.

2. Within ninety days after the expiration of this Grant, the Grantee will submit a report describing generally the beneficiaries of this assistance, their location, an estimate of their numbers, the duration and type of assistance provided and general difficulties experienced in distributing and accounting for commodities provided. The report should also describe generally the Grantee's staff supervision, monitoring and accounting processes to ensure proper use of the assistance. As part of this report, the Grantee will complete and submit to the A.I.D. Mission NGO Liaison Officer within 90 days of completion of the Grant the Final Evaluation Form contained in Attachment 4 to this Grant.

3. A.I.D. will use information provided in Grantee reports and from other sources to evaluate disaster assistance efforts conducted under this Grant.

E. Special Provisions

The following Optional Standard Provisions are attached and applicable to this Grant: Subagreements; Regulations Governing Employees; and Title to and Use of Property (Grantee Title)

F. Title to Property

Title to the property will vest in the cyclone-affected individuals to whom they have been distributed upon receipt. The Grantee will consult with USAID/Dhaka on the disposition of any commodities that cannot be distributed by the estimated completion date of this grant.

ATTACHMENT 2

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

A. Background

The catastrophic cyclone that struck the coast of southeastern Bangladesh on the night of April 29, 1991 has left millions of people stranded in coastal areas with little or no pure drinking water, food, clothing or shelter.

B. Objective

To provide immediate relief in the form of commodity donations to flood-affected people in a manner complementary to the Bangladesh Government's relief program.

C. Program

This Grant provides water purification tablets (WPTs) to SCF for distribution to cyclone-affected people. The Grantee is responsible for picking up the WPTs at a place in Dhaka designated by A.I.D. and for distributing it, or arranging for its distribution, within the period of the Grant, to cyclone-affected people in greater Chittagong and Mirarswari/Sitakundia.

It is anticipated that Grantee will distribute the WPTs through two other non-governmental organizations, CONCERN and NISERA KORI, in conjunction with a related A.I.D.-funded disaster assistance grant. Grantee personnel will distribute relief commodities directly to beneficiaries or through other organizations and individuals under the Grantee's direction and supervision. The Grantee will monitor the use of supplies provided under this Grant and document/account for their disposition in accordance with its standard practices and procedures, to the extent practicable under emergency circumstances.

In responding to the emergency, SCF will cooperate and collaborate with governmental and other non-government organizations, when and where appropriate.

D. Reporting, Dates and Commodities

Reporting requirements, effective date and estimated completion date, and nature and quantity of commodity grant shall be as set forth in the Schedule, Attachment 1 to this Grant.
