Attached are the subject documents that were signed on September 30, 1993, by Dr. Mutahar Abdullah al-Saeedi, Vice Minister of Planning and Development and William D. McKinney, A.I.D. Representative. The three Grant Agreement Amendments provide an additional \$1,000,000 for the following two U.S.-assisted Projects:

- 1. Non-funded Accelerated Cooperation for Child Survival Project (279-0082), Grant Agreement Amendment Number No. 9, returns the life of project funding to its original level of \$12,708,000.
- 1. Options for Family Care Project (279-0090), Grant Agreement Amendment Number No. 3, to accomplish the following:

Adds \$1,000,000 in grant funds to the project, bringing the total U.S. contribution to date for the project to \$5,160,000. The total life of project funding is \$10,600,000.

The Amplified Project Description in the Project Agreement is amended to reflect a realignment of project activities and a change in the method of providing technical assistance. The project now has two major priorities of (a) improving population policy and planning, and (b) integrating and strengthening maternal/child health and family planning service delivery at user and community levels. Technical assistance for the project will be provided primarily by one institutional contractor in place of several part-time contractors.

3. Non-funded Development Training III Project (279-0080), Grant Agreement Amendment Number No. 12, to accomplish the following:
- The Amplified Project Description in the Project Agreement is amended to reflect a realignment of project activities. Project activities now include; (a) selected long-term participant training, (b) continued and expanded assistance to Yemeni women's associations, (c) administrative and management training for Yemen's Parliament, and (d) other selected in-country management training.
  - Decreases the life of project funding from \$75,000,000 to \$55,000,000. The total U.S. contribution to the project to date is \$47,609,734. This decrease reflects the more modest U.S. assistance levels currently available for Yemen, but still allows for additional resources to be added to the Project.
