- B. Commodities \$ 24,000 - for the purchase of training supplies and equipment, research and laboratory equipment, and office supplies and equipment.
- C. Other Costs \$ 96,000 - for construction of two grain storage warehouses and local budget support as specified in the Project Paper.
- D. Participant Training \$ 78,000 - for financing new and continued training in the U.S. or third countries for participants nominated by the GOB and accepted for training by USAID.
- II. The terms and conditions of Project Agreement TQ-B-4, dated August 31, 1976, apply to the assistance financed by this agreement.
- III. The Ministry of Finance and Development Planning agrees to execute an assignment to AID upon request of any cause of action which may accrue to the Ministry in connection with or arising out of a contractor's performance or breach of performance of any contract financed in whole or in part out of funds provided by the United States Government under this agreement.
- IV. Exemption for Duties and Taxes
- Pursuant to the terms of the attached Standard Provisions Annex, which is part of this Agreement, the Government of Botswana agrees to arrange for the exemption from or for reimbursement of:
- a. All duties and taxes imposed on and relating to the import of household and personal effects (including one motor vehicle) which are the property of each U.S.-supplied technician or his family intended for their own personal and/or domestic use and are imported by him within a period of six months of his arrival at his post of assignment. If any of the above effects are sold prior to re-export, the U.S.-financed specialists will be liable to pay duty or taxes on them at appropriate rates.
 - b. All export duties and taxes on the above items.
 - c. All social security taxes, personal taxes and all direct taxes on all income of the U.S. supplied staff received from the U.S. Government either directly or indirectly.
