PROJECT AGREEMENT

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. Project Title: Democracy and Human Rights (Ugandan Courts)	2. AID Project Number 698-0541.17
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3. This Project consists of the provision of basic recording and photocopying equipment to the Ugandan Courts so that court operations may be improved. Up to a limit of \$15,000, equipment consisting of tape recorders, photo-copying machines and voltage regulators will be purchased by USAID/Uganda for distribution within the Court system by the Chief Justice or his designee.

USAID/Uganda will purchase the equipment using a Project Implementation Order for Commodities (PIO/C). Included will be an initial supply of paper and tapes. The Chief Justice or his designee will draft and obtain USAID/Uganda concurrence to a distribution plan. The plan shall indicate the criteria to be used by the Chief Justice or his designee in selecting the courts to be recipients of the equipment.

The Project Assistance Completion Date is September 30, 1993. This is the date by which all goods provided under this project shall have been furnished. The grant funds are to be used as soon as practicable to purchase and distribute the equipment.

A.I.D.'s contribution to the activity is \$15,000. The estimated in-kind contribution of the Ugandan Courts is \$5,000 as indicated in the attached grant budget (Attachment 1 to Annex A).

The Judiciary Court agrees that it shall provide, no later than September 30, 1993, to USAID/Uganda a written report on the distribution, location, use and effectiveness of the equipment provided under this project.
