
6 - This agreement consists of title page and project description annex. The purpose of the Agreement is to provide manpower development in the priority areas of health, and rural and agricultural redressement.

Project Description

1 - PROJECT TITLE

African Manpower Development

2 - AID PROJECT NUMBER

698-0384.31

3 - ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION :

- a) This activity provides manpower development support to the health and the agricultural sectors.
- b) In the health sector, working through the Ministry of Health and Social Affairs, three health specialists will participate in various training programs in the United States. These training programs will be in the areas of maternal and child health care, and endemic disease control.
- c) In the agricultural and rural redressment area, working through the Ministry of Rural Economy, three agricultural specialists will participate in various training programs in the United States. These training programs will be in the areas of agricultural extension services, rural development studies, and forestry.

4 - SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- A) Prior to the commencement of training, the grantee will furnish to AID, in form and substance satisfactory to AID,

- evidence that the salaries of those persons selected for training will continue during the training period.

- evidence that those persons selected for training will return to the same or higher positions within their respective Ministries.

- B) Reference to "this Agreement" means the original Project Agreement as modified by any revisions which have entered into effect. Reference to "cooperating country" means the country or territory of the Grantee.
- C) 1) AID will make available the amount specified in Block 3 of this Agreement, as necessary for the project, as may be further described in Annex A.
- 2) The Grantee will make available the amount specified in Block 4 of this Agreement, as necessary for the Project, as may be further described in Annex A.
- D) AID shall expend funds and carry on operations pursuant to this Agreement only in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations of the United States Government.
- E) The present Agreement shall enter into force when signed. Either party may terminate this Agreement by giving the other party thirty (30) days written notice of intention to terminate it. Termination of this Agreement shall terminate any obligations of the two parties to make contributions pursuant to Blocks 3 and 4 of this Agreement, except for payments which they are committed to make pursuant to noncancellable commitments entered into with third parties prior to the termination of the Agreement.
