18. SUMMARY DESCRIPTION
This Amendment (One) (1) to the PAAD (633-T-601A) is consistent with the original PAAD approved by the Assistant Administrator for Africa on July 8, 1988, which delegated authority to the USAID/Botswana Mission Director to authorize incremental non-project assistance funds for this project, subject to the availability of funds.

This Amendment one (1) approves a second tranche of \$500,000 — making a total of \$1,400,000 approved to date for the Sector Assistance Grant components.

All Conditions Precedent to the First Tranch Disbursement were satisfactorily met: A general Review of Progress to Date within the Sector has been completed and submitted to USAID. (It is appended to this PAAD Amendment.) USAID has therefore determined that satisfactory progress has been made by Botswana

within the Population Development Sector. USAID and the GOB will proceed with the second year implementation of the Population Assistance Program.

The overall Grant Agreement Amendment will contain the following Conditions Precedent for disbursement of this second tranche of funds under the Sector Assistance Grant Component:

"Prior to the disbursement of the second tranche of the sector assistance to be provided under the Grant, the Grantee shall provide to USAID, in form and substance satisfactory to AID:

- (1) Evidence that the Grantee is preparing and consolidating draft National Population Program Guidelines, including the holding of consultations and discussion within the Government and with the Public;
- (2) Evidence that the Government's designated office responsible for the coordination of population activities and programs has adequate staff and facilities to function appropriately;
- (3) Evidence that CMS has initiated the implementation of the plan for procurement and distribution of contraceptives;
- (4) Evidence of a proposed introductory plan for the expansion of IEC services to be provided by Family Health, Health Education and District Health Education Teams;
- (5) Evidence of the initiation of the 1989 plan to improve the quality and effectiveness of existing MCH/FP clinical services and to significantly increase the number of service delivery points;
- (6) Evidence of the initiation of the 1989 plan to increase participation of NGOs in Population Programs, including private sector entities.

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
