

# Field Trip Report

**District visited:** Bardiya and Kailali (Kanchanpur)

**Objectives of the visit:**

To facilitate last 2 days training of CB-IMCI portion for HPIs /DHO assistants in both district Bardiya and Kanchanpur.

## Background

CB-IMCI Training into three districts is the major activities of this fiscal year. Before conducting these training activities in the districts a district level planning workshops were conducted to finalize the activities and fix the dates for trainings. According to the district's planning most of the training activities has been conducted in Nawalparasi and Bardiya .Due to the budgetary problem in WHO some batches of SHPI/AHW/ANM training were postponed in Nawalparasi and Bardiya. In Kanchanpur all training program could not be conducted as planned due to same budgetary problem. So in consultation with districts a reschedule of the remaining training activities were done by CDD/ARI section .Child Health Division.

JSI/Nepal has been providing technical support to CDD / ARI section e.g. facilitation of the training, supervision, monitoring and materials supply for the program . Accordingly concerning regional JSI officers and central level officers have been involved in each level of training and monitoring activities.

## **Findings**

All trained facilitators were involved in IMCI training in Bardia and Kanchanpur. Following the 9 days IMCI course, last two days community level package were introduced by JSI Central and field officers in Bardiya and also in Kanchanpur.

HPI training of Kanchanpur was conducted in regional training center Dhangadi. Participants had got good opportunity for comfortable accommodation as well as appropriate environment for training. Participants were very interested and motivated towards the program. Sufficient training materials were used and distributed during the training. Similarly SHPI/AHW/ANMs training of Bardiya conducted in district headquarter.

CARE Nepal has sent three participants for this training and they have planned to be involved as facilitators in SHPI/AHW/ANM training in the future.

DPHO Jay Bahadur Karki has shown very keen interest and involved in the training as full time participants.

Based on community level two days curriculum following points were focused which are as follows:

- Community level ARI case management
- VDC orientation /Sustainability
- Mothers group orientation
- Supervision / Monitoring
- Recording / Reporting for all level
- Training methods
- Training procedures of community level program (Micro teaching)
- Traditional healers orientation

## **Suggestion and recommendation**

To provide opportunity to good AHW/ANM to serve as facilitators training of all AHW/ANMs of all level should be conducted prior to community level training and also to keep the interest alive on the remaining training.

For running fiscal year, Ministry of Health Child Health Division does not have any plan to introduce IMCI program in other districts. However three participants from Kapilvastu were participated in Kanchanpur HPI level training which may result the shortage of teaching learning materials and other necessary support regarding the regular supply of cotrim. timer and other program materials. In the other hand there are so many procedures to be applied before introducing the IMCI program in the district for the sustainable development and its coverage.
